


# COVID-19 Mobility Update

6/18/20




The average miles traveled daily increased 0.8 miles over the last week – up 5% week over week and 68% versus the April low.

## USA Average Weighted Average By County


Distance traveled daily is now at **91%** of the travel occurring the first week of March prior to COVID-19 restrictions.




# USA Average Weighted Average By County

Average miles traveled on the weekend are returning to previous levels. Both days were up a mile+ week over week. Saturday and Sunday are now exceeding the second weekend in March.

Saturdays




Sundays

Average miles traveled on weekdays is now surpassing levels seen mid-March and is at 90% of the distance traveled the week of March 2nd. There was a 5% increase week over week.
