


COVID-19 Mobility Update

The average miles traveled daily decreased slightly over the last week, but remains up significantly versus the April low at 73%.


Avg Total Miles Traveled Per Day



Data for the week of 6/22 are preliminary and subject to change.

Distance traveled daily is now at **93%** of the travel occurring the first week of March prior to COVID-19 restrictions.


Distance traveled is 1.2 miles less per day than per-COVID levels.




USA Average Weighted Average By County

Saturdays




Sundays



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Average miles traveled on weekdays is now surpassing levels seen mid-March and is at 94% of the distance traveled the week of March 9th. There was an increase of a tenth of a mile week over week.


Average Week Day



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The number of people traveling beyond one mile from their homes daily has stabilized, with approximately 3 out of 4 people leaving their homes on the average day.
