

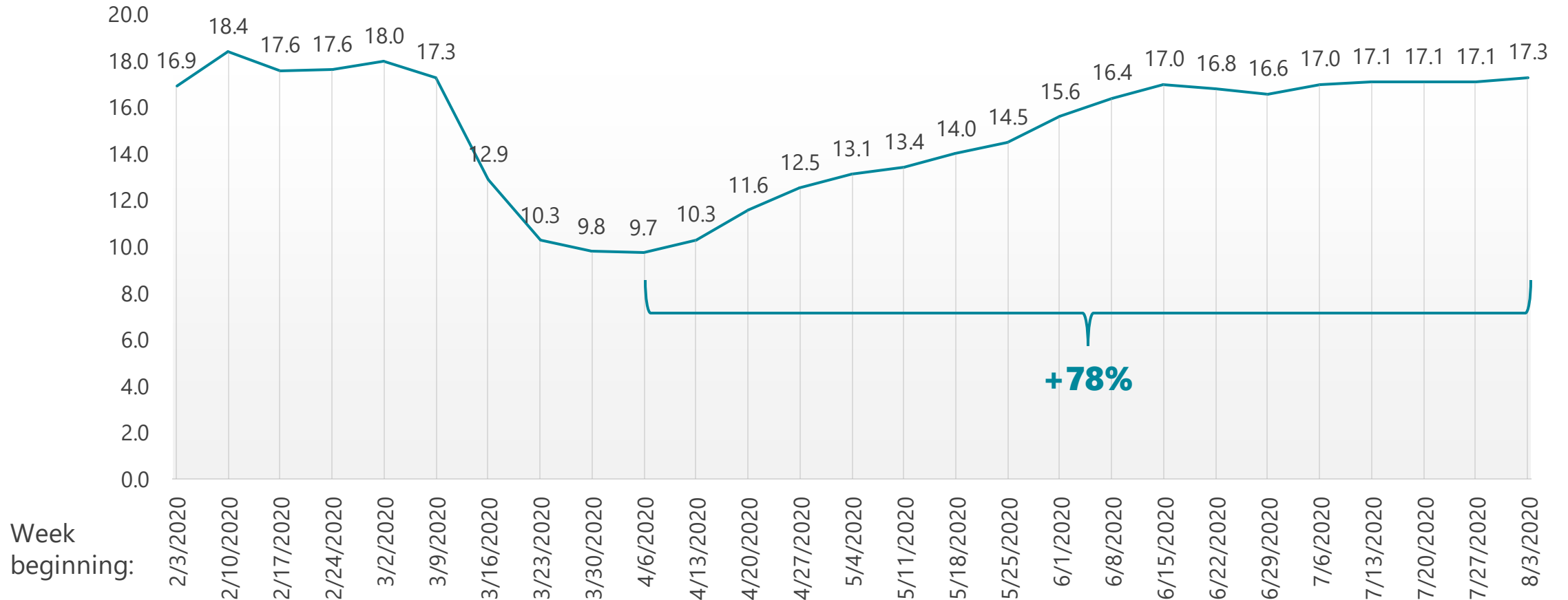
COVID-19 Mobility Update

The average miles traveled daily ticked up slightly this week - up 78% versus the April low.

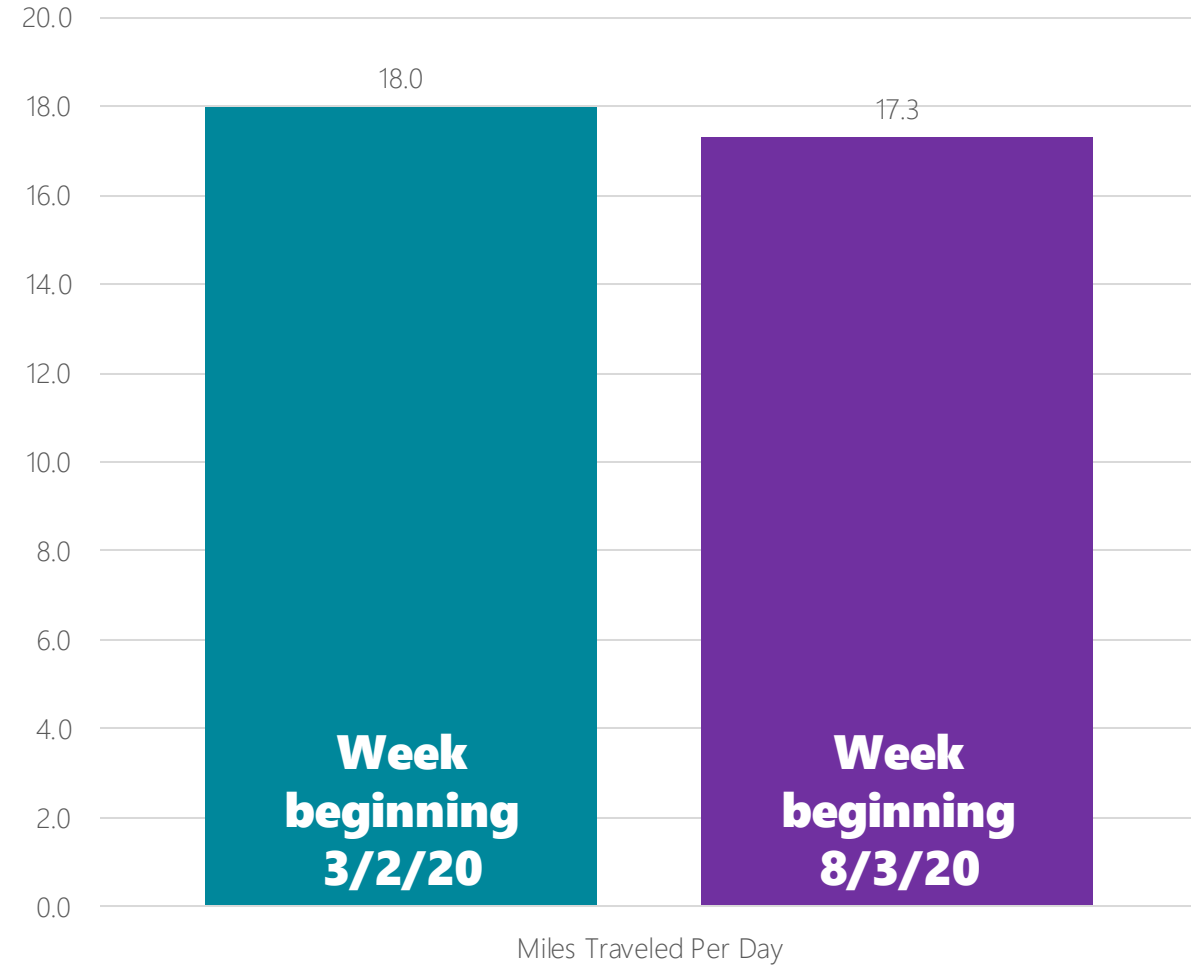
Avg Total Miles Traveled Per Day

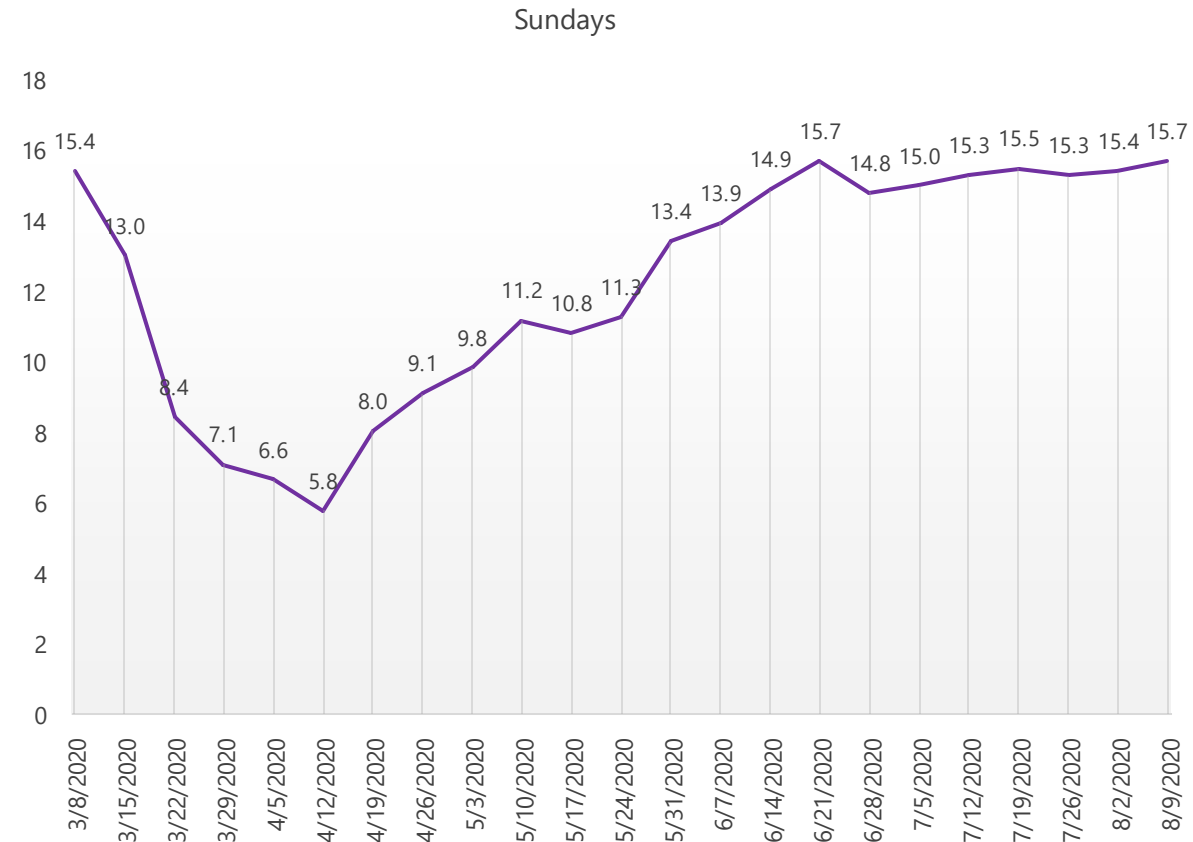
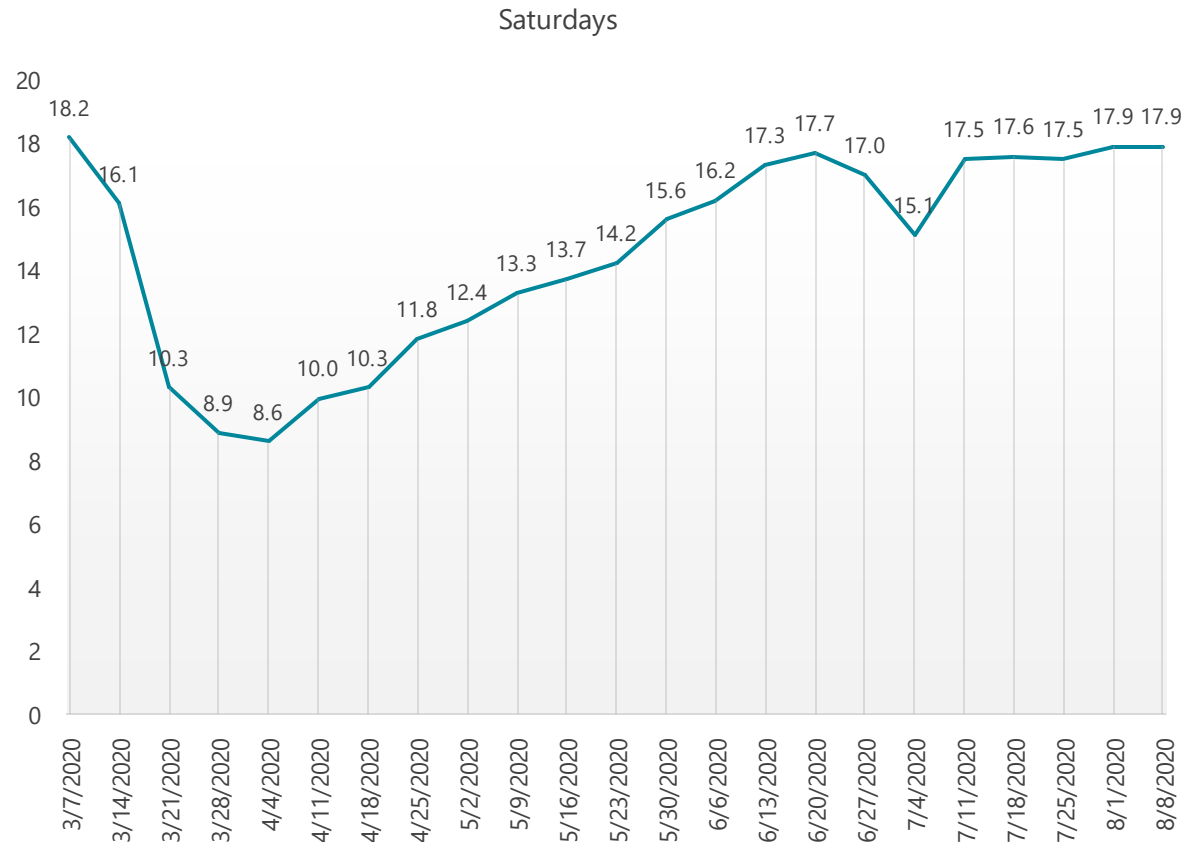
USA Average Weighted Average By County

USA Average Weighted Average By County

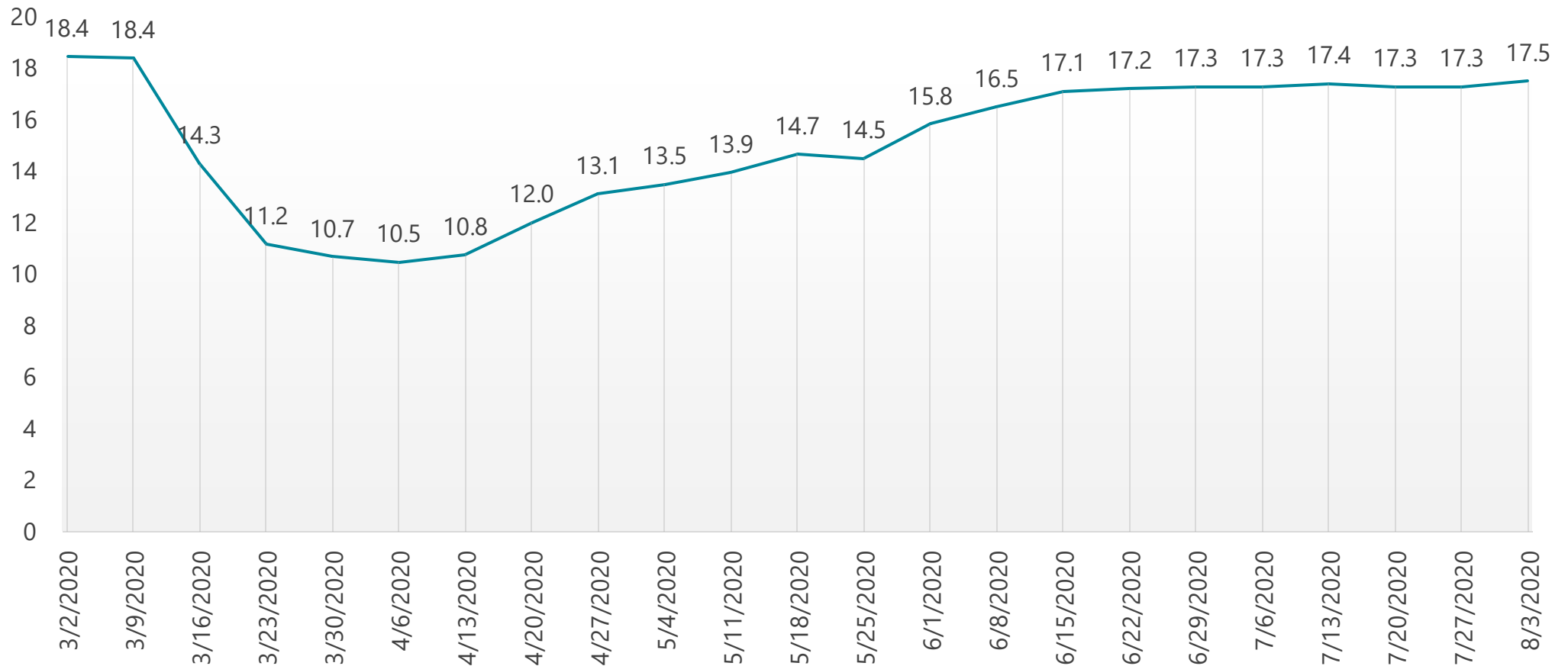
Saturday distance traveled held steady for the week. Sunday distance traveled increased slightly and has now surpassed early March.

Average miles traveled on weekdays has stabilized, surpassing levels seen mid-March. Currently, people are travelling 95% of the distance traveled the week of March 2nd.

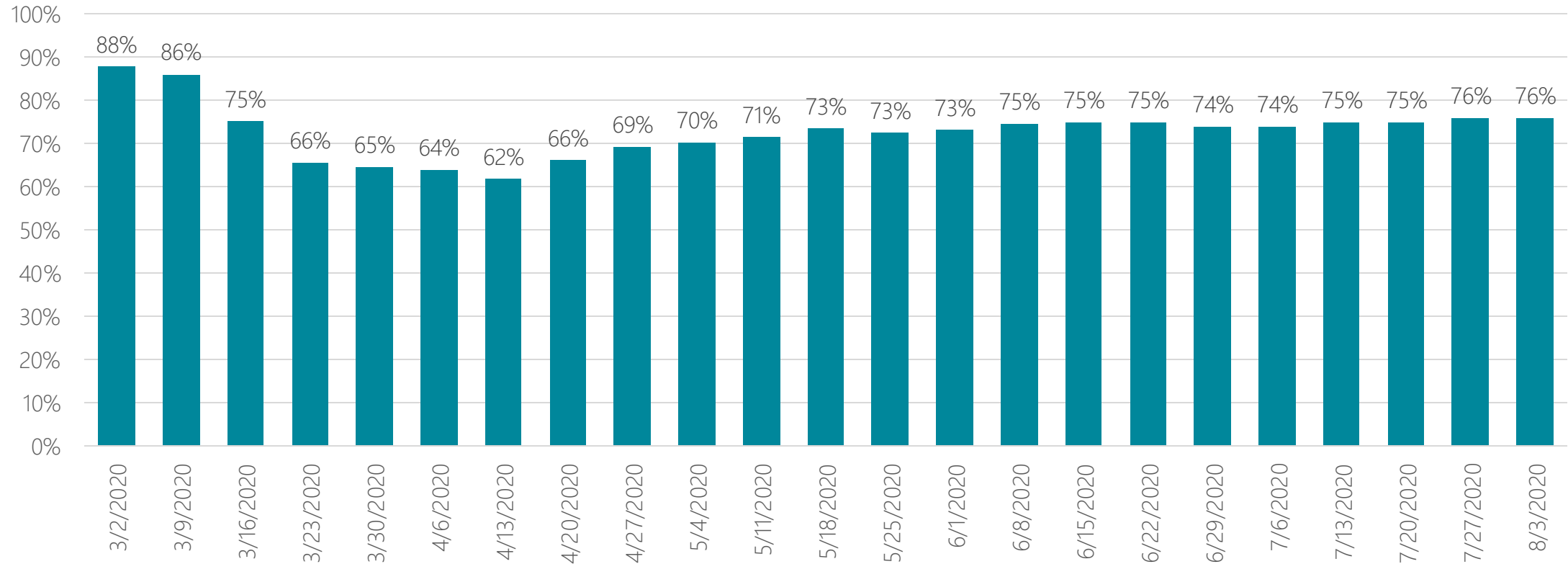
Average Week Day
