

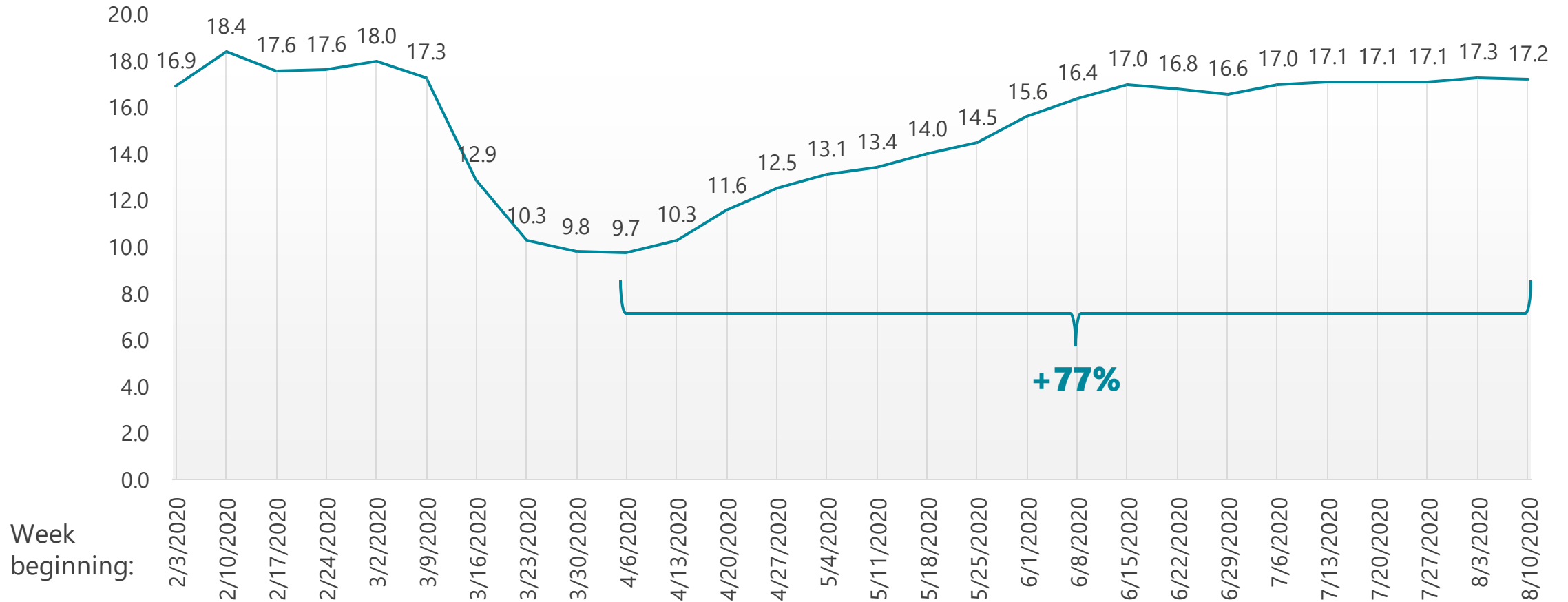
COVID-19 Mobility Update

8/20/20



The average miles traveled daily across the US continues to hover at stable levels, up 77% versus the April low.

Avg Total Miles Traveled Per Day

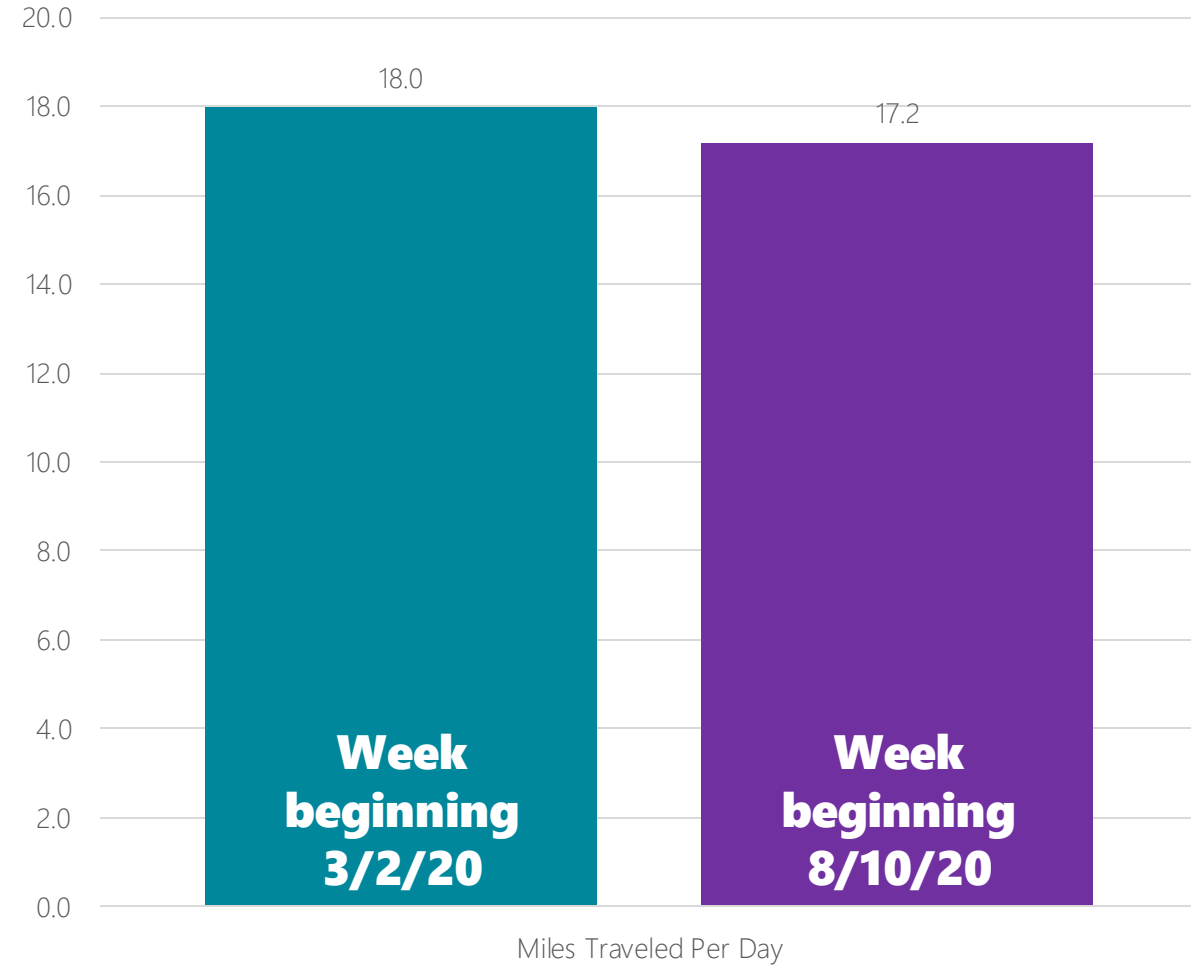

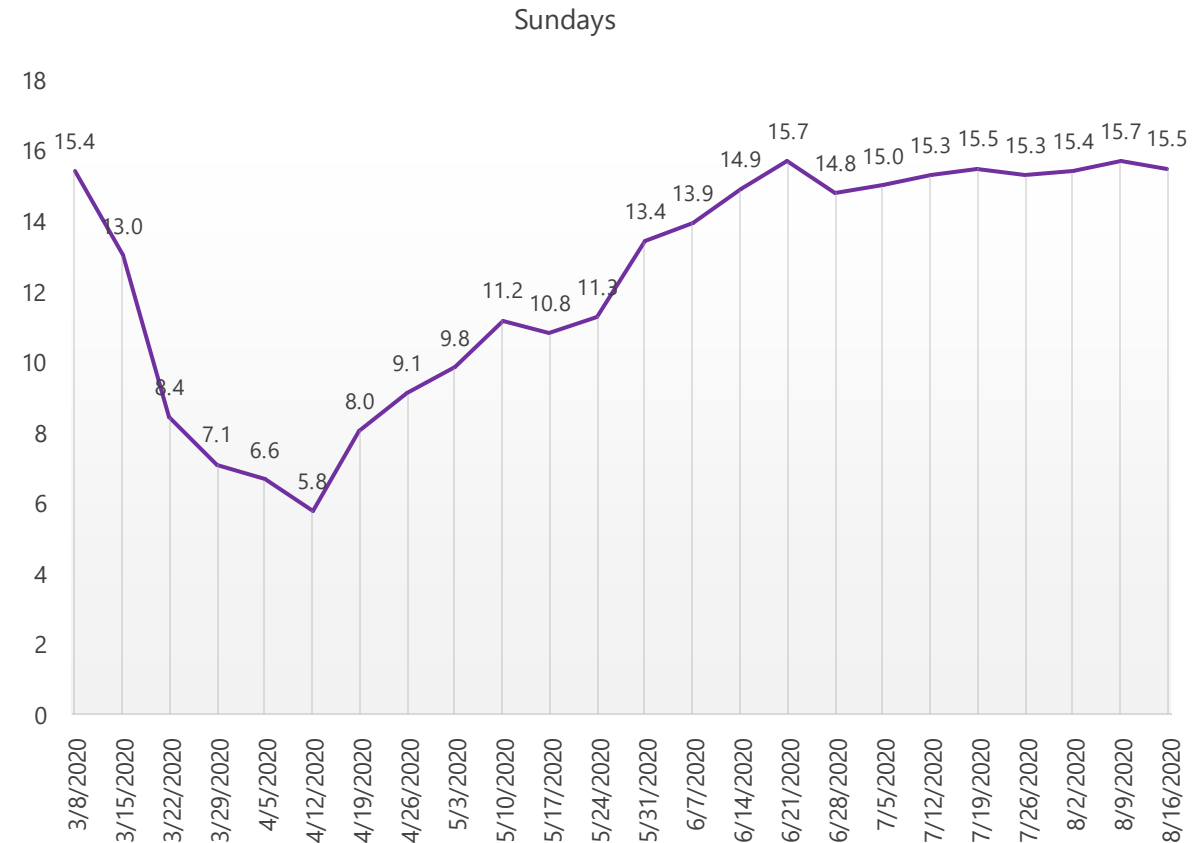
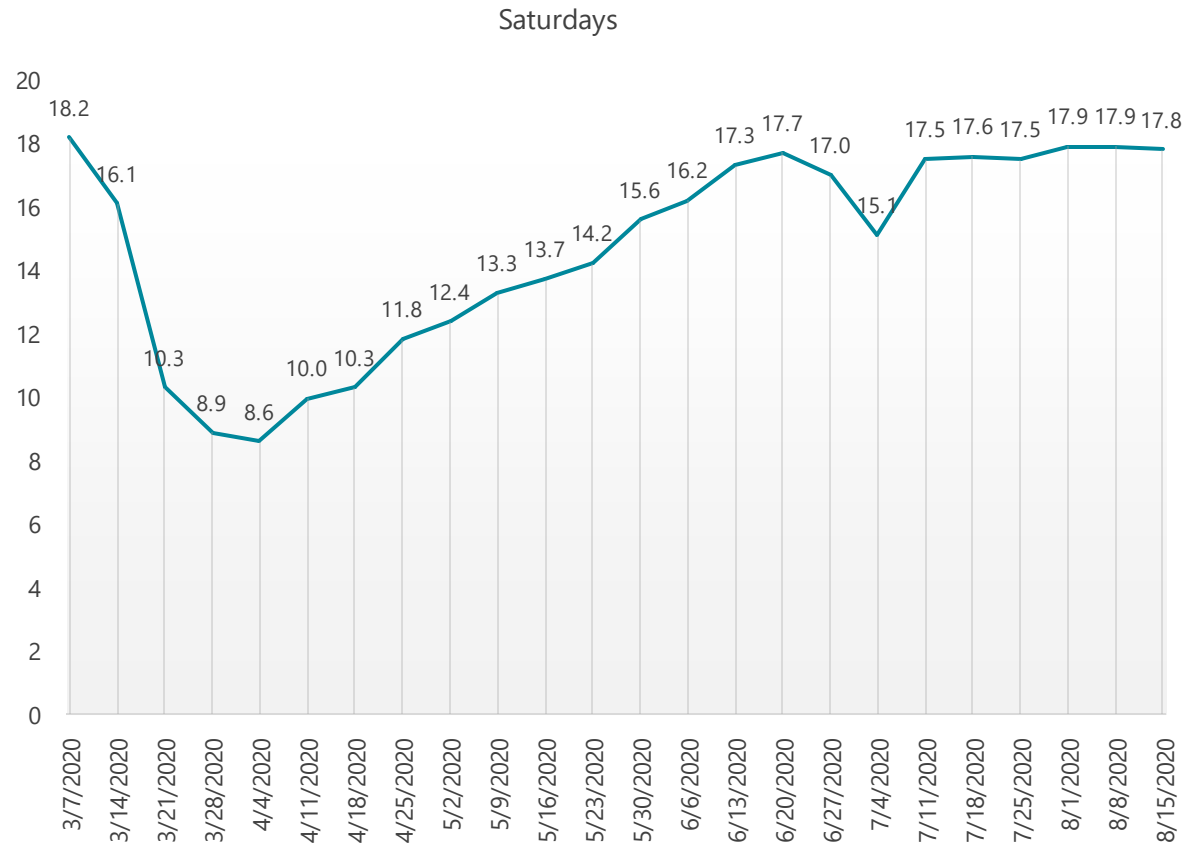
USA Average Weighted Average By County

Average miles traveled daily continue to stabilize at around **96%** of the travel occurring the first week of March prior to COVID-19 restrictions.



USA Average Weighted Average By County

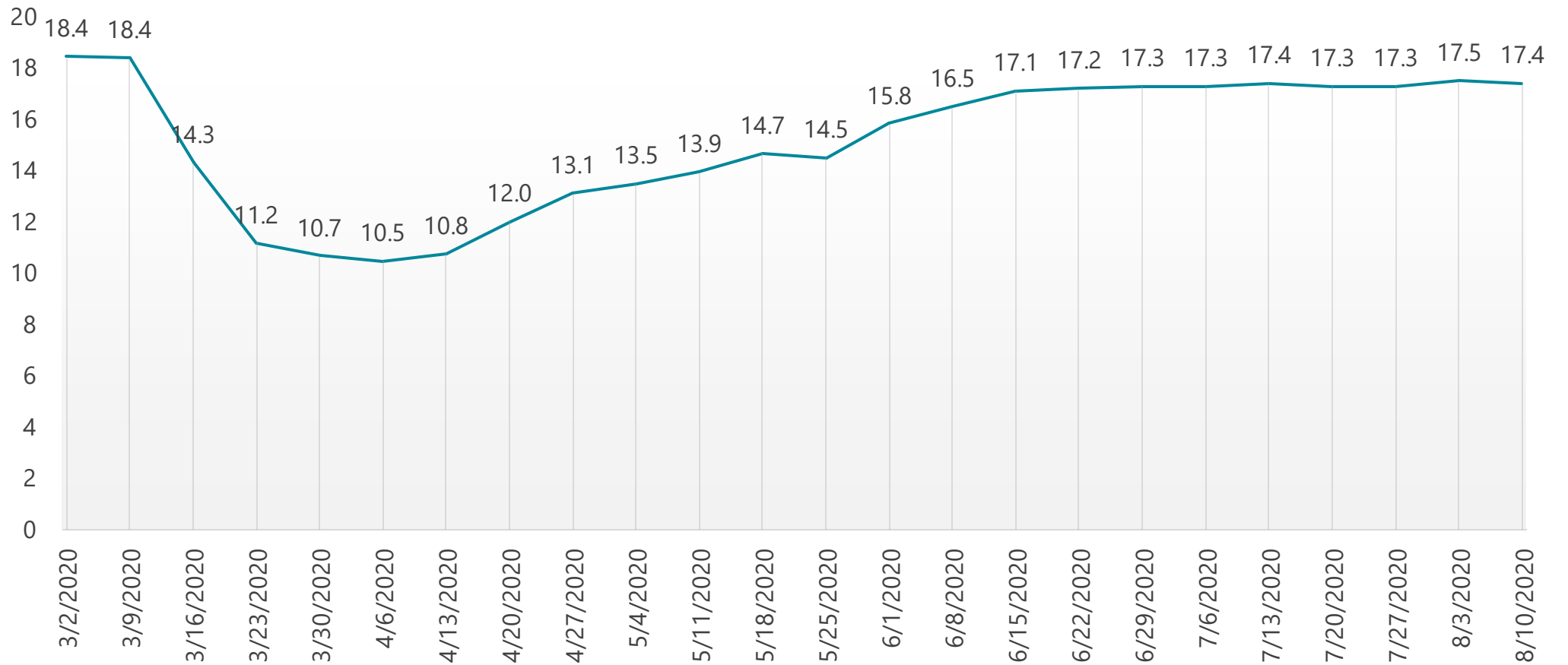
Saturday distance traveled held steady for the week. Sunday distance traveled increased slightly and has now surpassed early March.

Average miles traveled on weekdays has stabilized, surpassing levels seen mid-March. Currently, people are traveling 95% of the distance traveled the week of March 2nd.

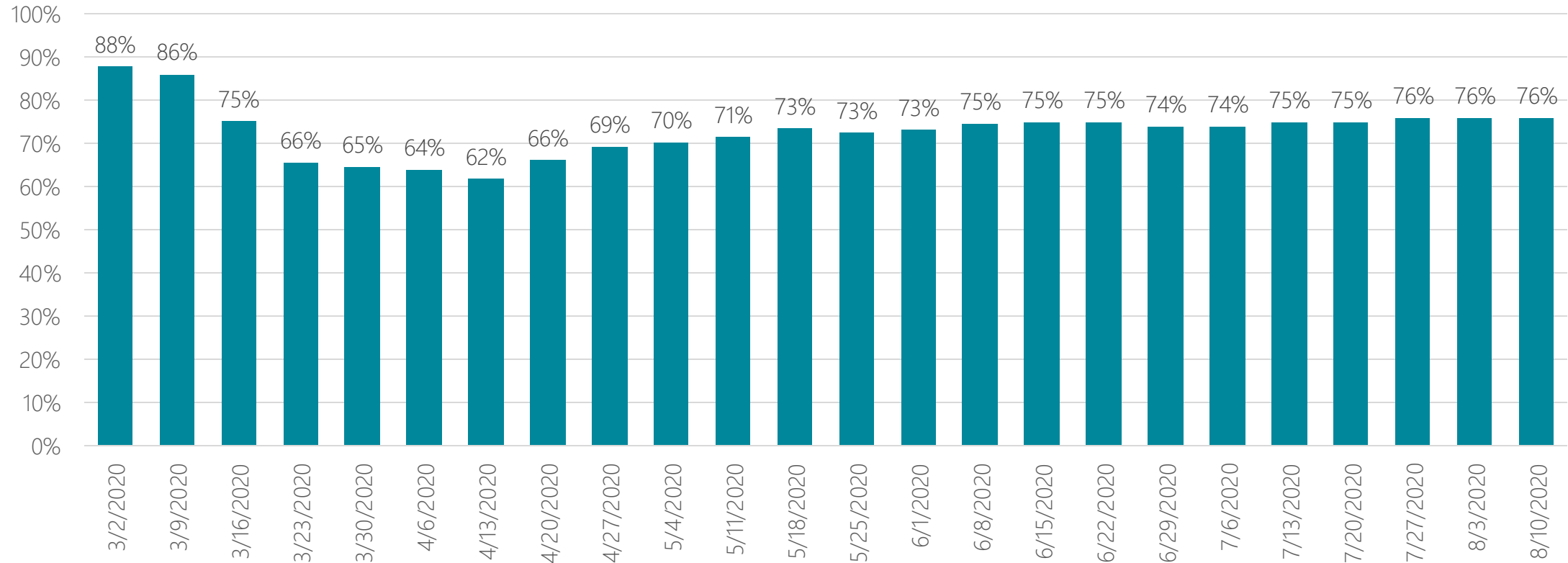
Average Week Day

The number of people traveling beyond one mile from their homes daily has stabilized, with approximately 3 out of 4 people leaving their homes on the average day.

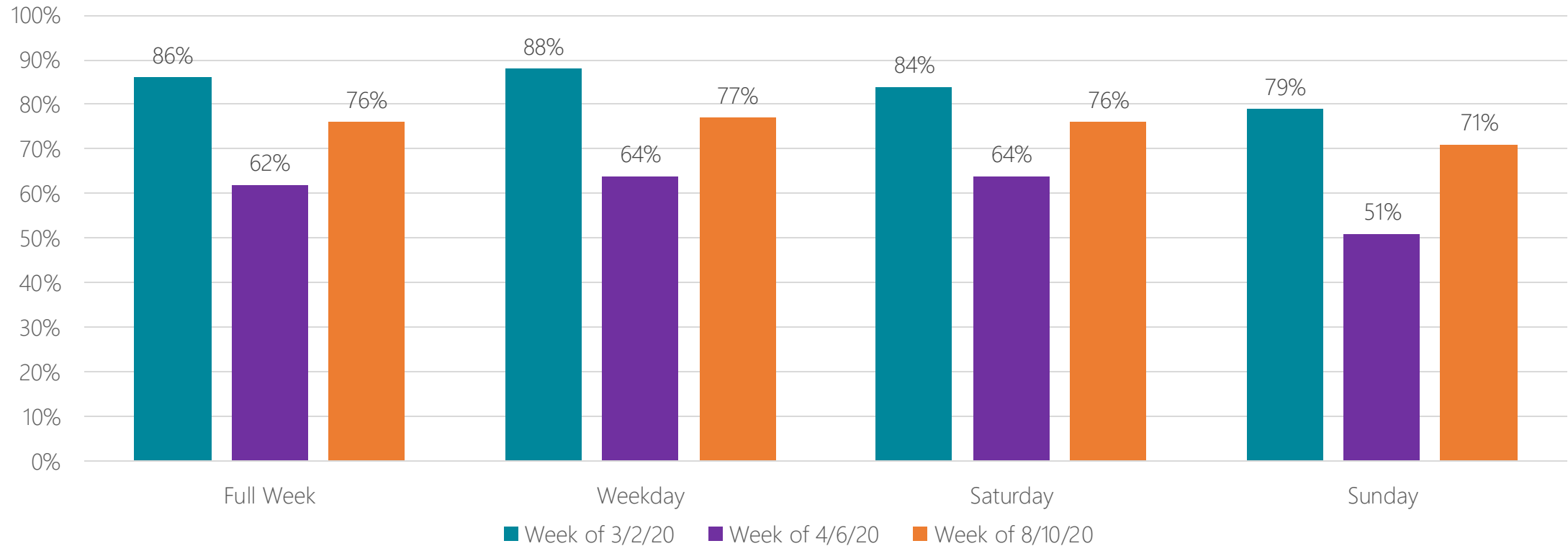
% Of People Leaving Their Homes – Average Day

Regardless of the day of the week, the number of people leaving their home in an average day hovers at around 90% of the first week in March pre-COVID.
