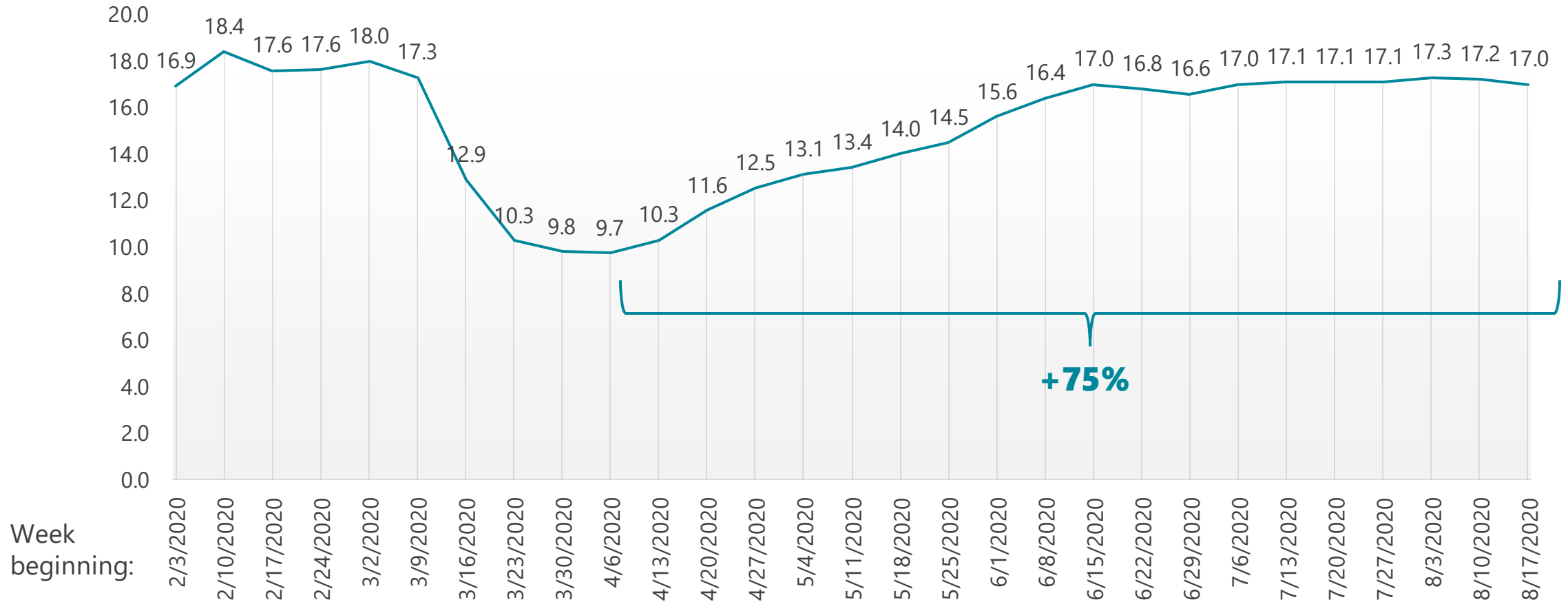

USA Average Weighted Average By County

The average miles traveled daily across the US continues to hover at stable levels around 17 miles per day, up 75% versus the April low.

Avg Total Miles Traveled Per Day

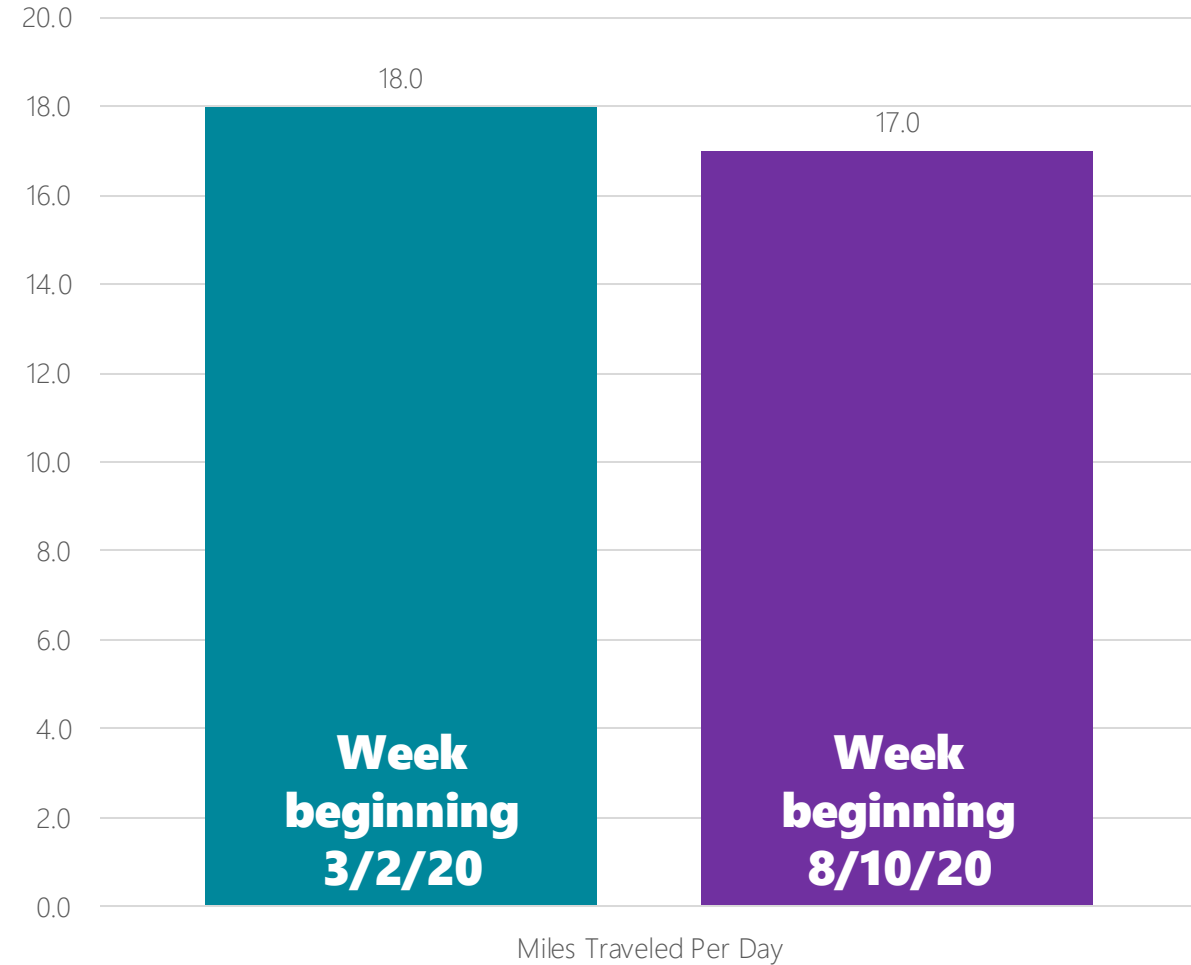

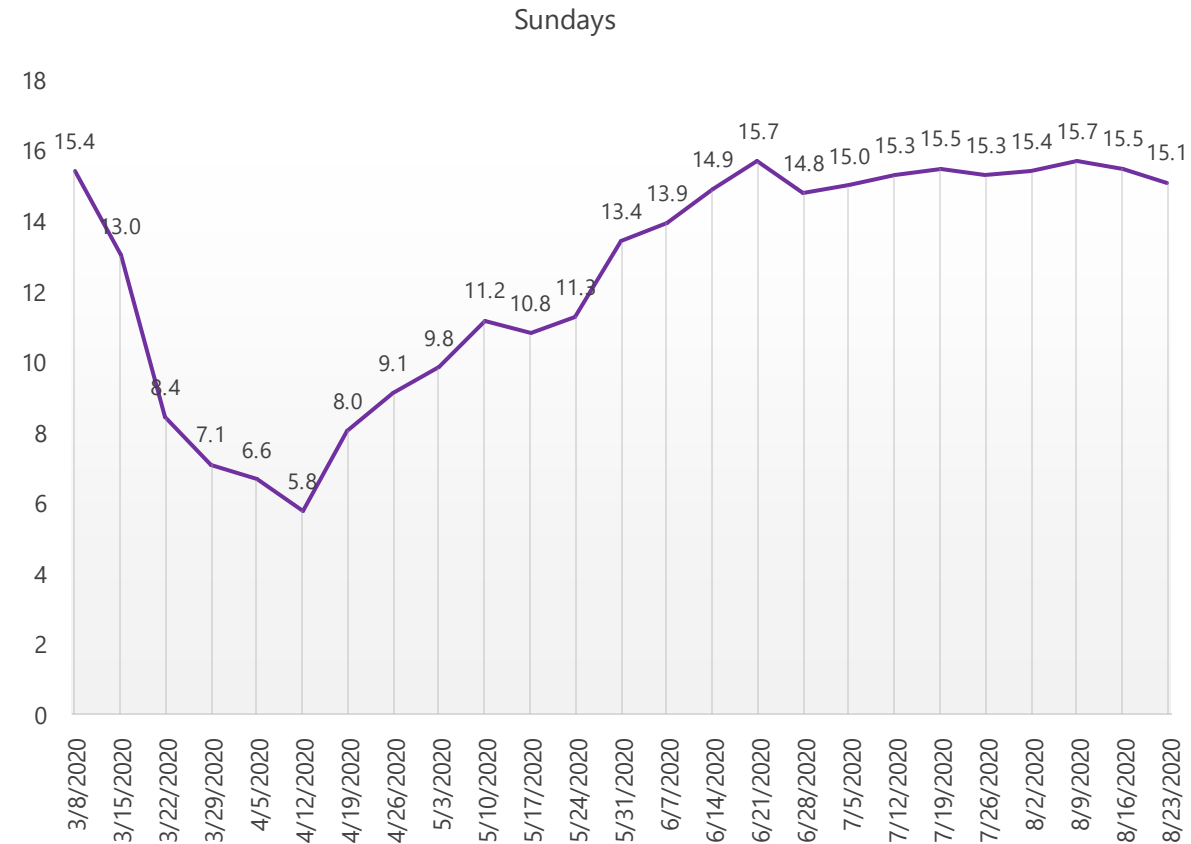
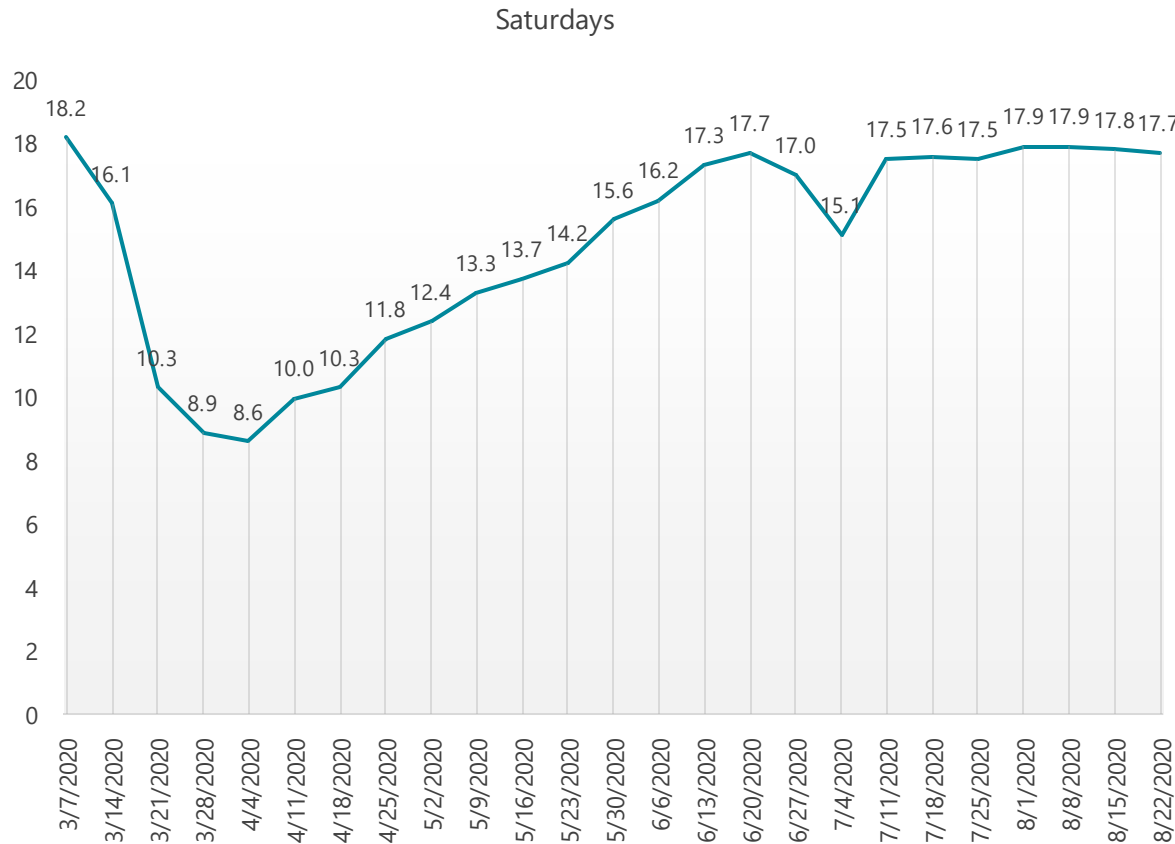
USA Average Weighted Average By County

Average miles traveled daily continue to stabilize at around **94%** of the travel occurring the first week of March prior to COVID-19 restrictions.



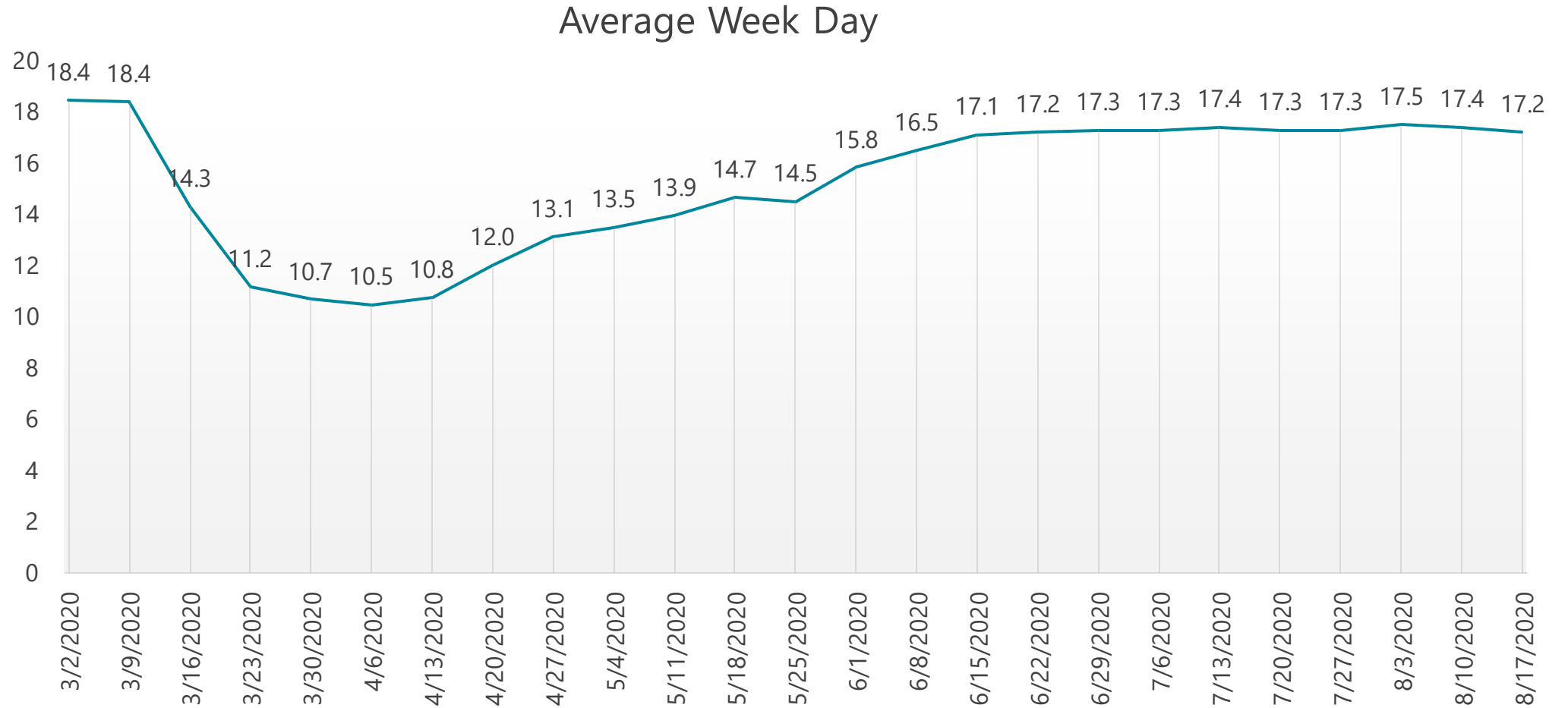
USA Average Weighted Average By County

Saturday distance traveled held steady for the week. Sunday distance traveled saw a 4/10ths of a mile drop week over week.



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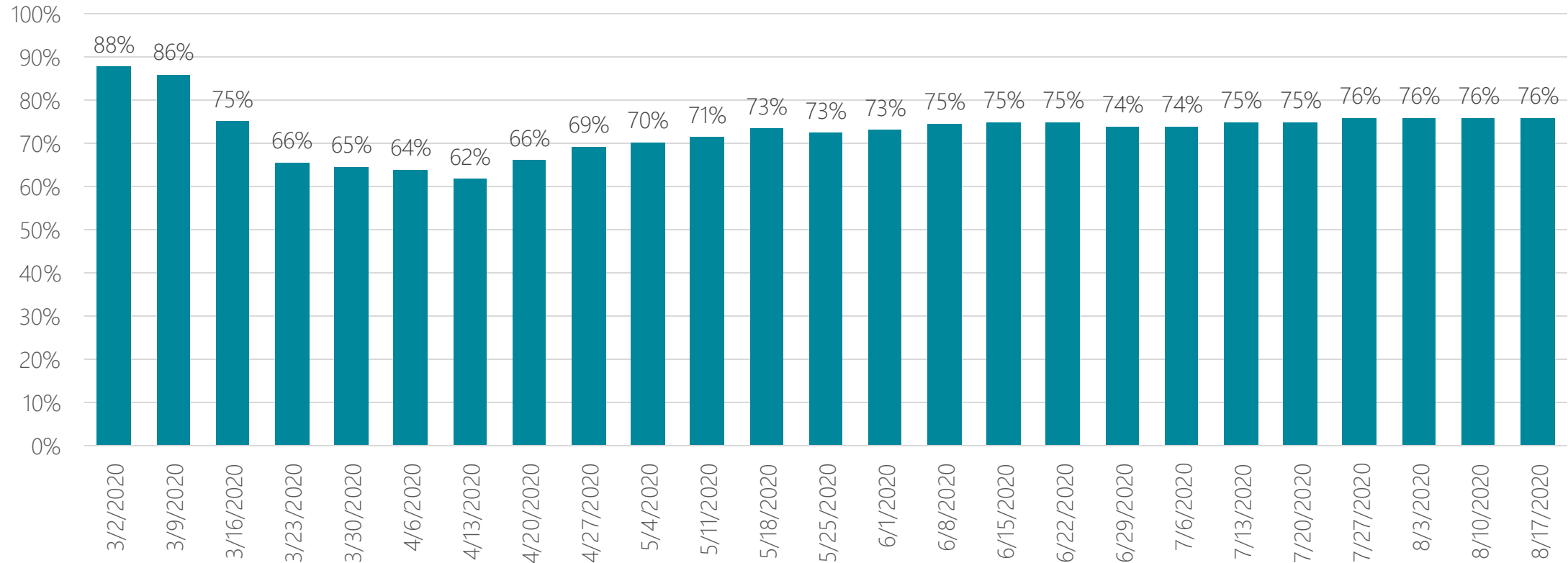
Average miles traveled on weekdays has stabilized between 17.1 and 17.5 over the last 10 weeks, surpassing levels seen mid-March.



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The number of people traveling beyond one mile from their homes daily has stabilized, with approximately 3 out of 4 people leaving their homes on the average day.

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Versus the April low, many states are seeing increases of 10+ miles per day on average.
