

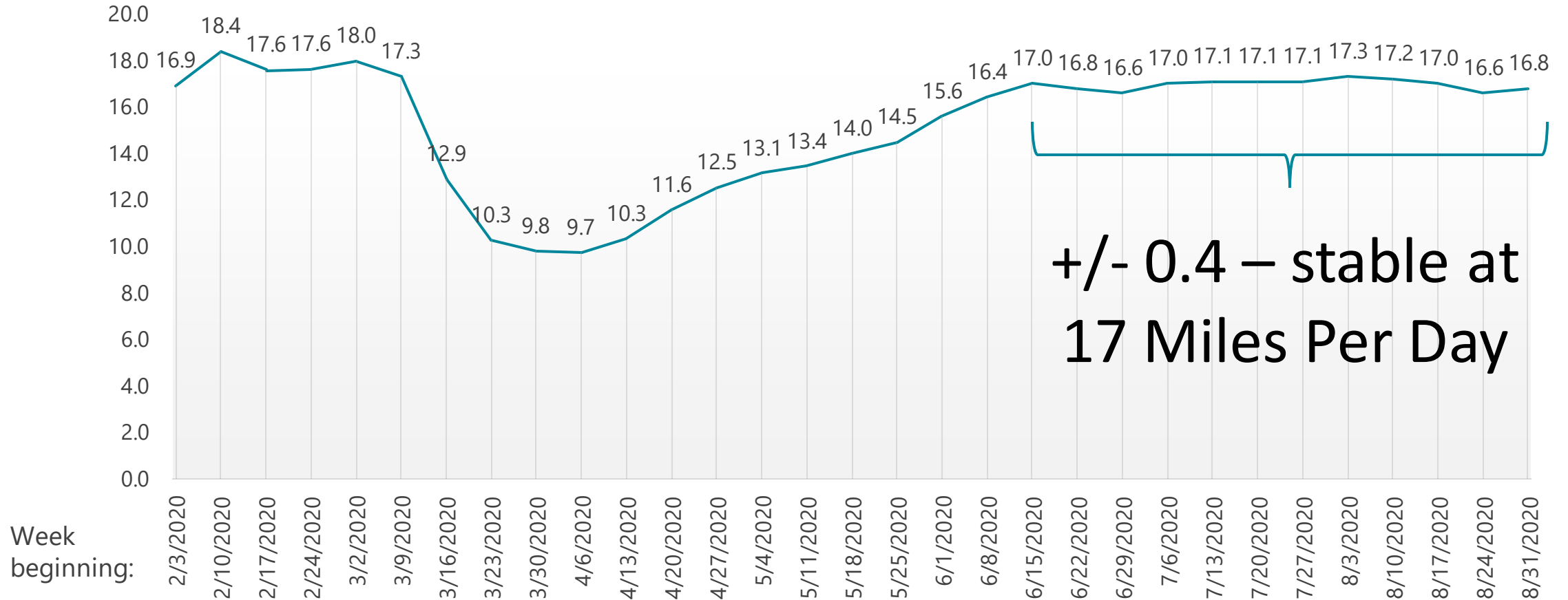
# COVID-19 Mobility Update

The average miles traveled daily has continued to hover around 17 miles a day for the last 12 weeks.  
The week of 8/31 is 73% higher than the April low, up two-tenths of a mile week over week.

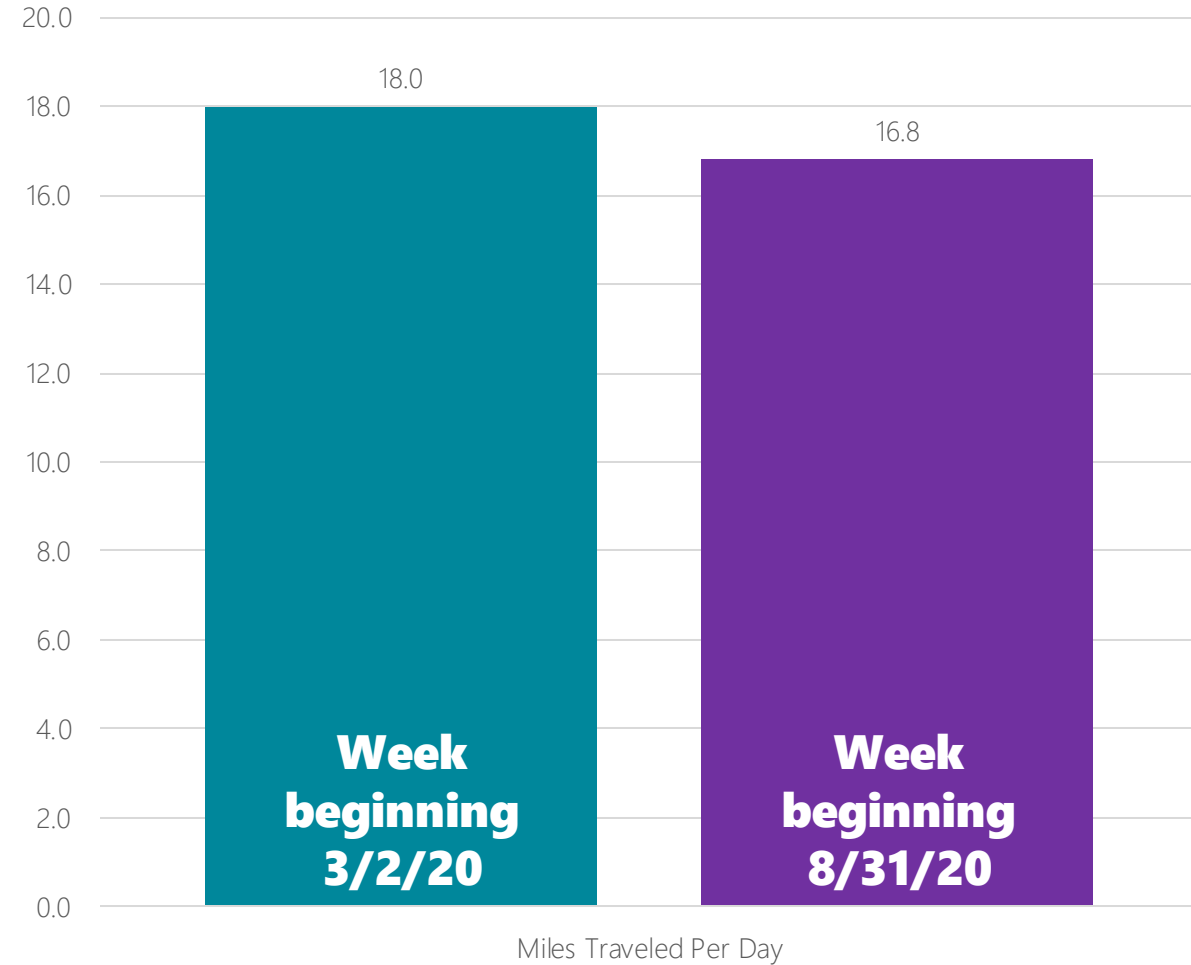
Avg Total Miles Traveled Per Day

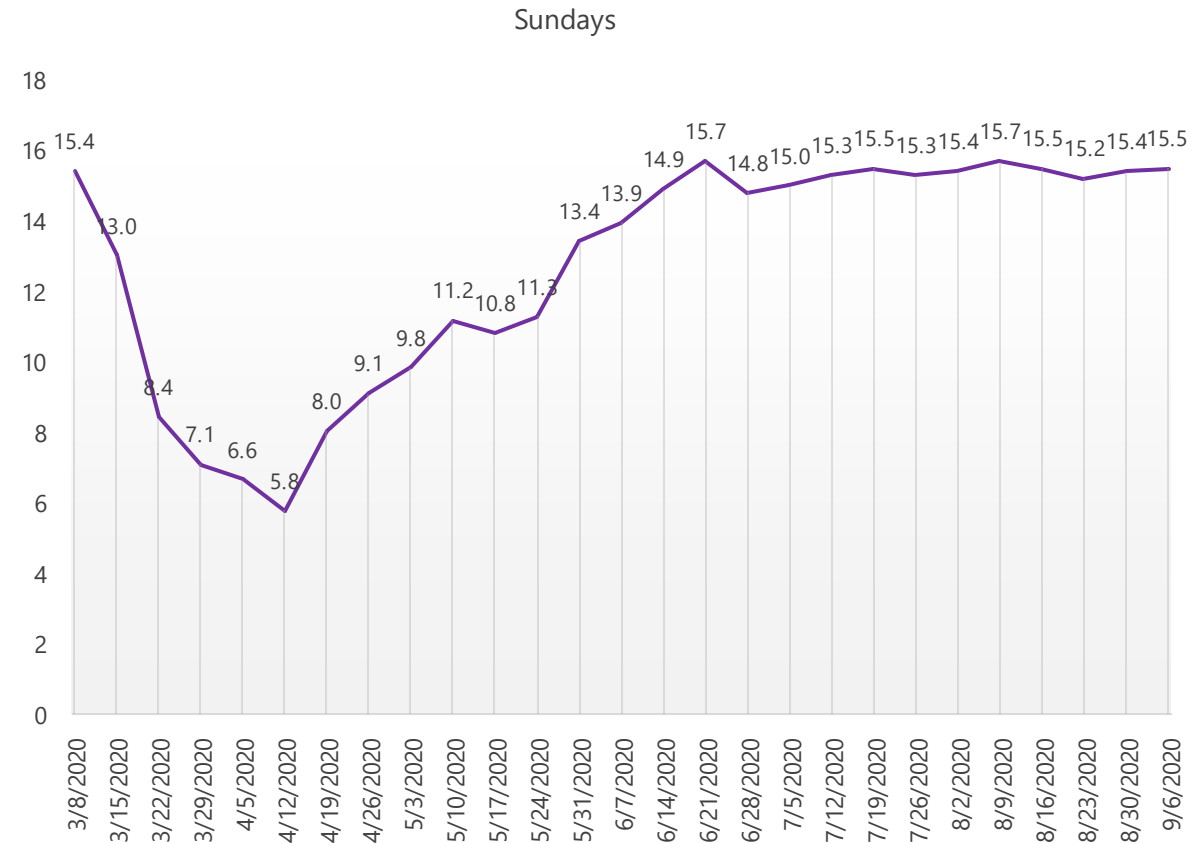
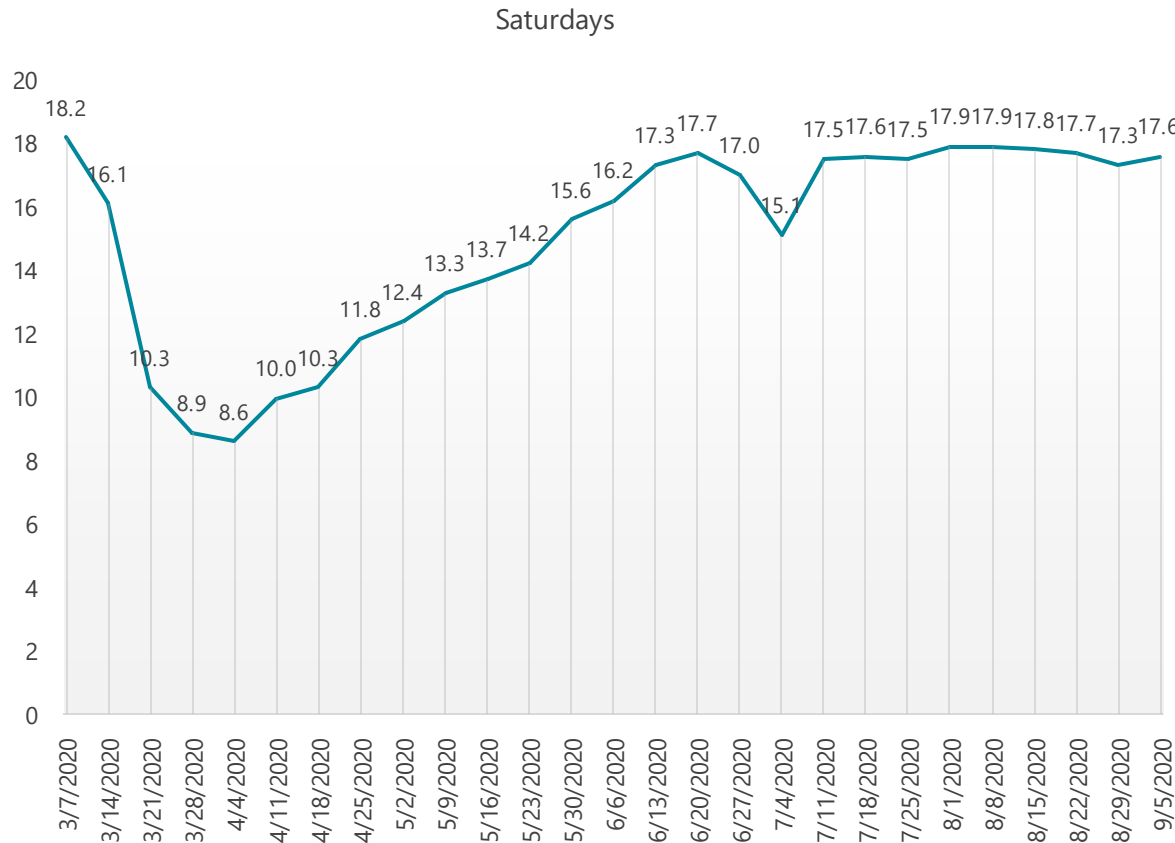
## USA Average Weighted Average By County

Average miles traveled daily for the week of 8/31 represents **93%** of the travel occurring the first week of March prior to COVID-19 restrictions.



# USA Average Weighted Average By County

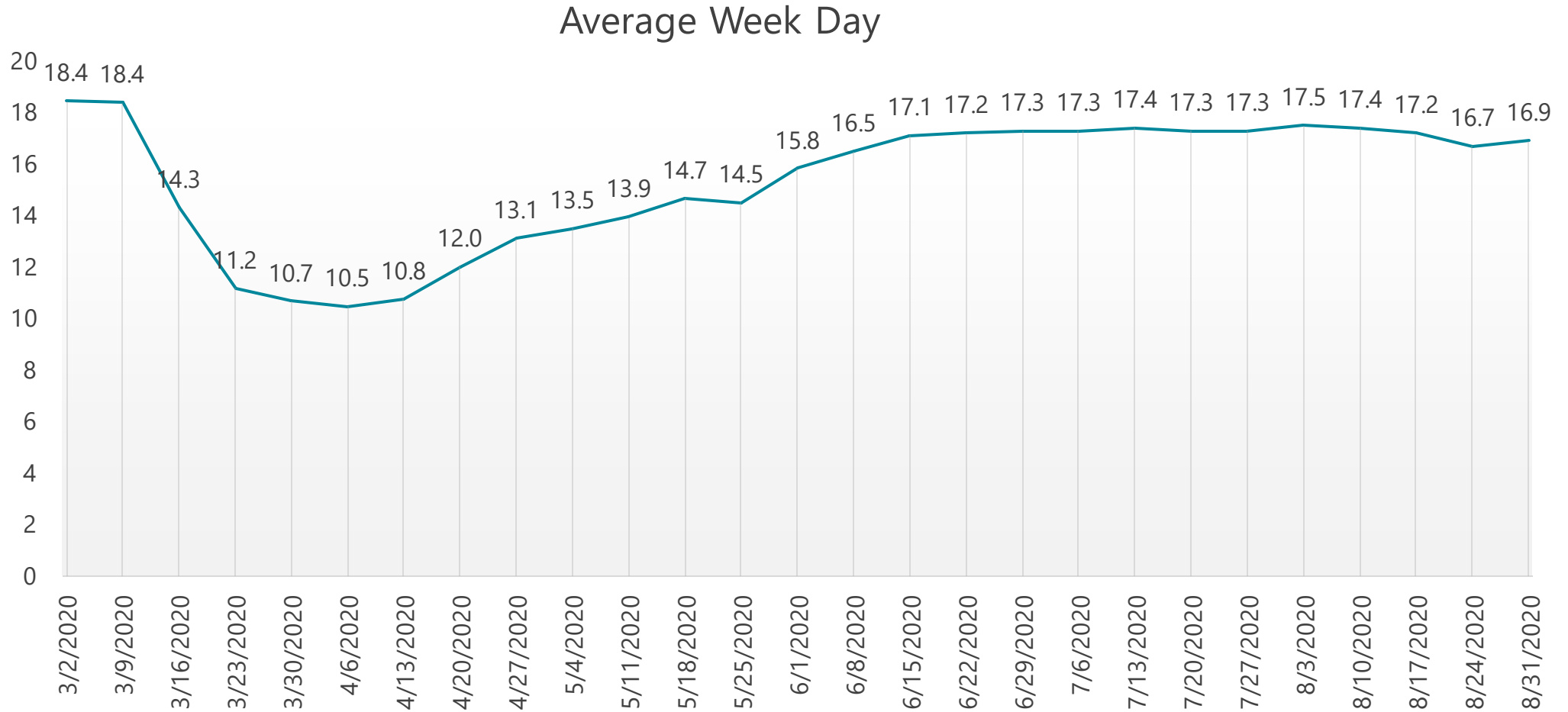
Miles traveled over the weekend were stable, with Sunday matching early March mile for mile.

# USA Average Weighted Average By County

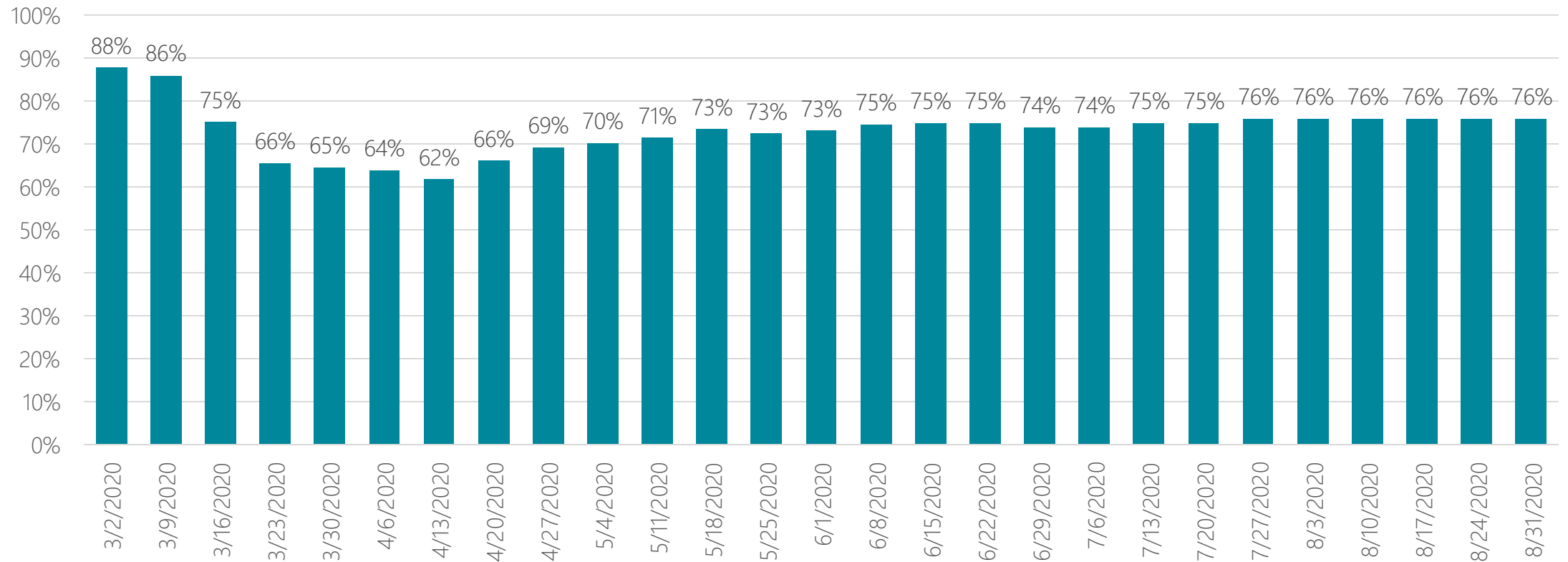
Average miles traveled on weekdays increased two-tenths of a mile week over week.
