

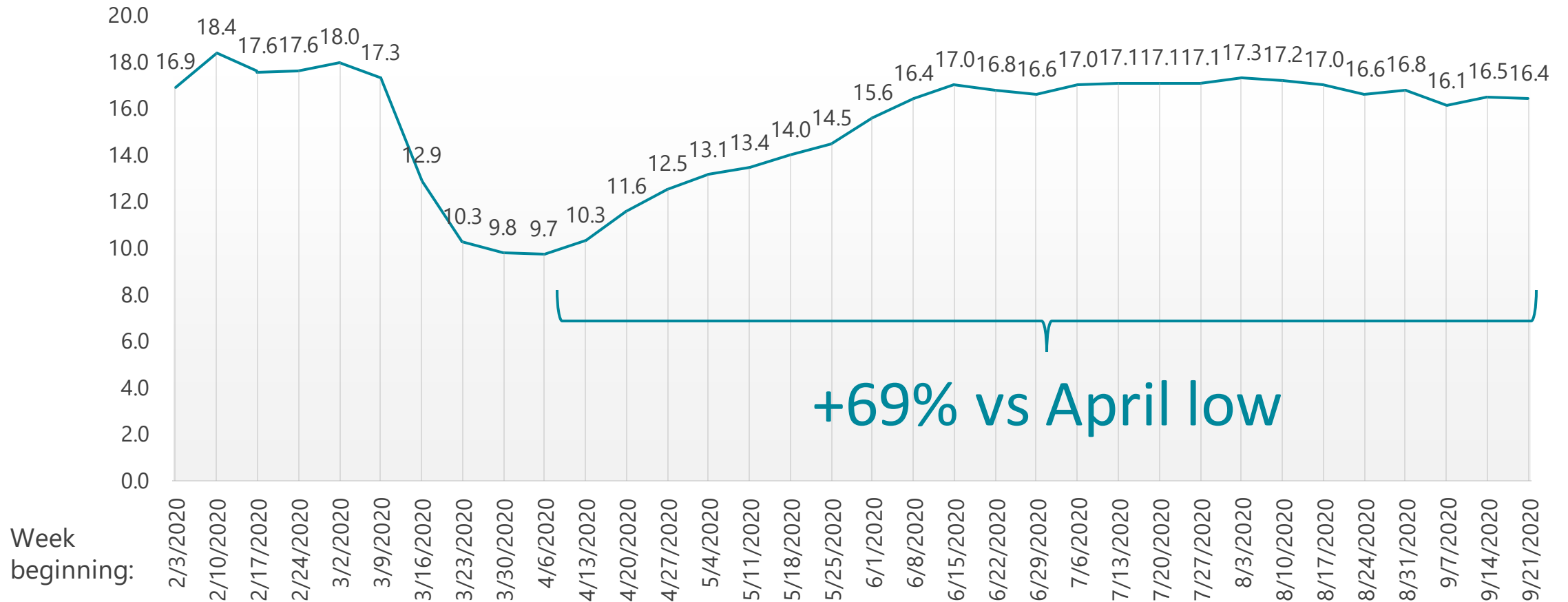
# COVID-19 Mobility Update

Average miles traveled per day were relatively flat week over week.

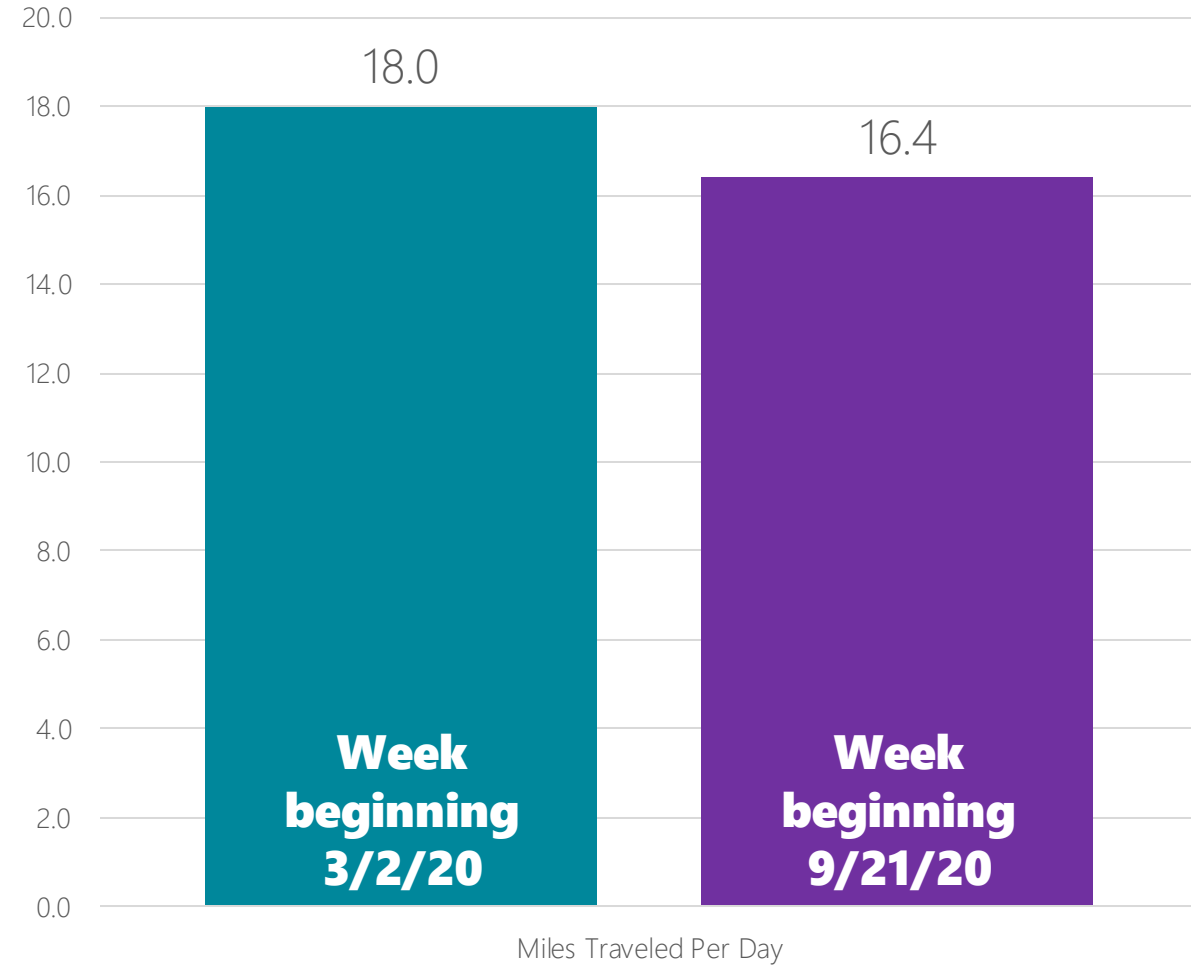
Avg Total Miles Traveled Per Day

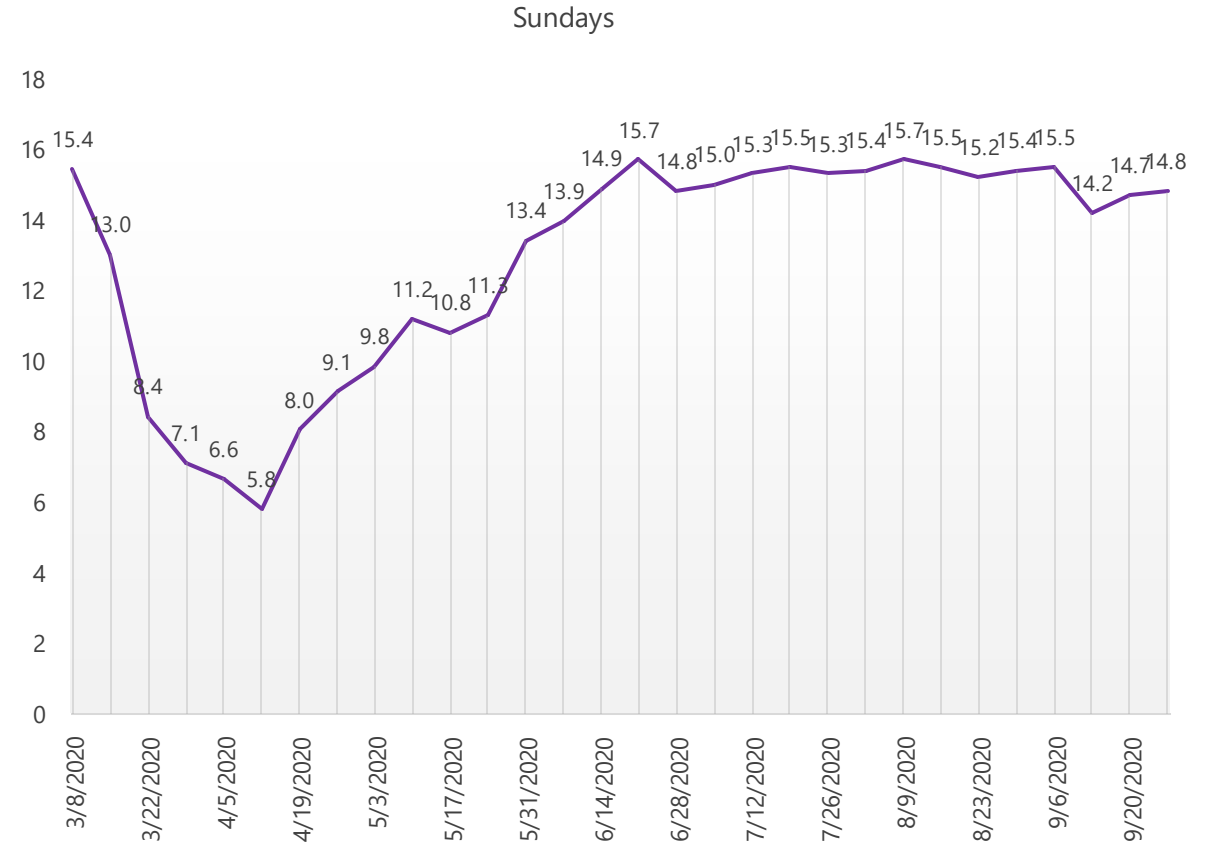
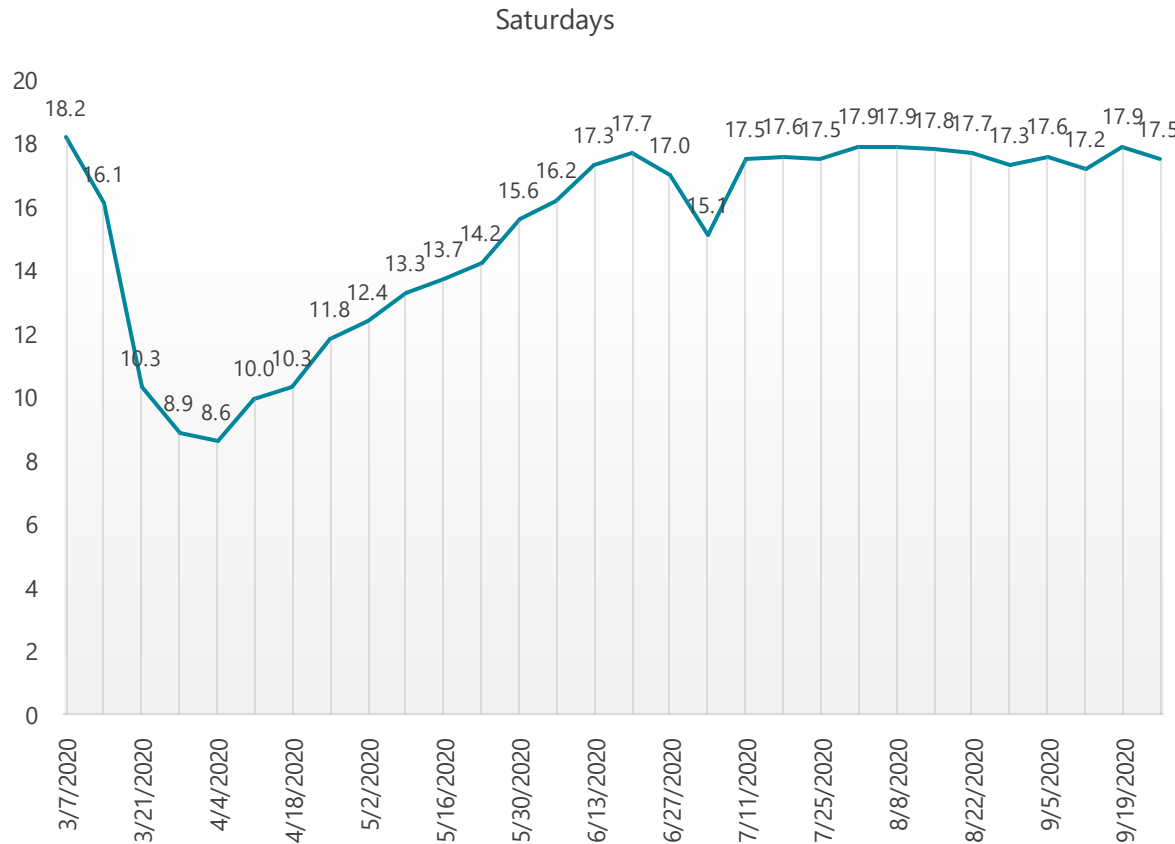
## USA Average Weighted Average By County

# USA Average Weighted Average By County

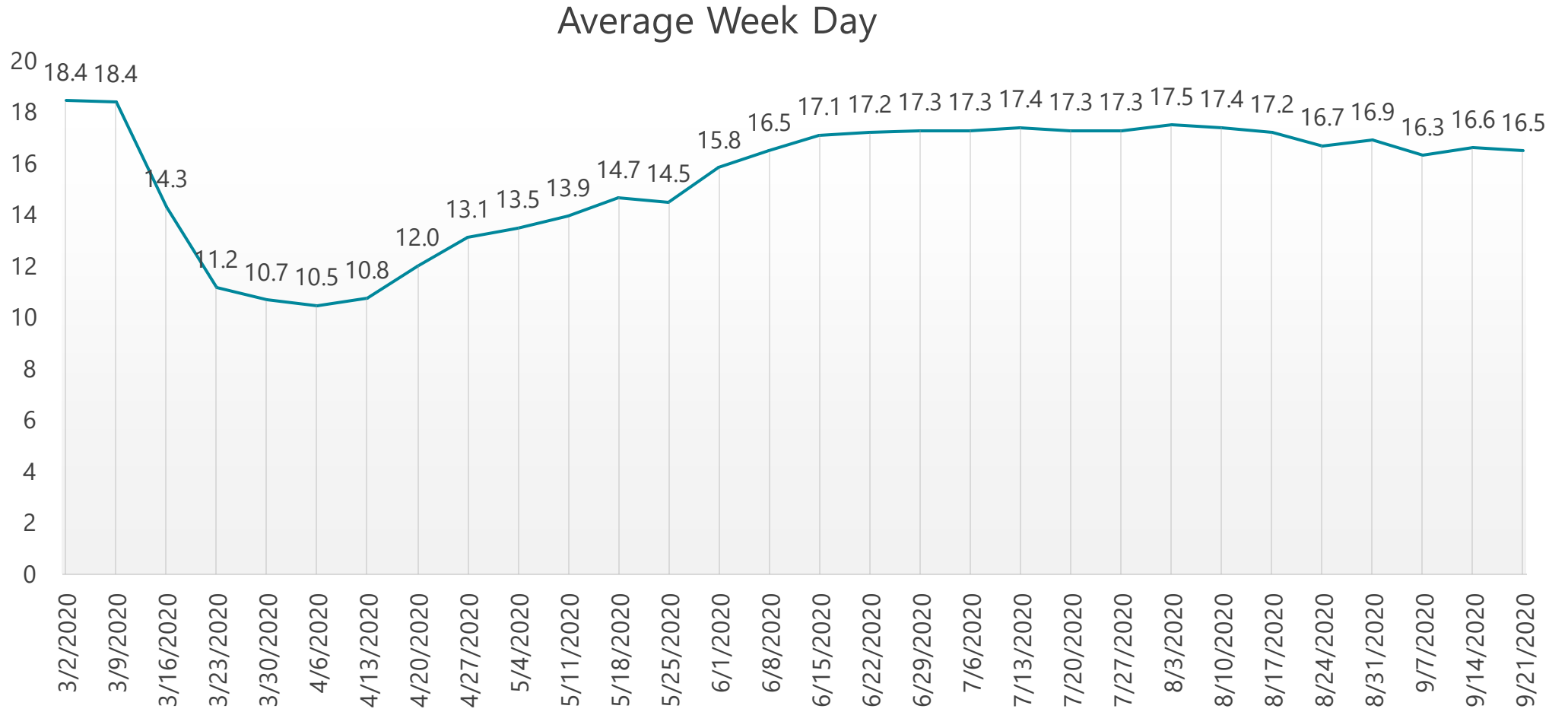
Miles traveled on the weekend continue to stabilize.

# USA Average Weighted Average By County

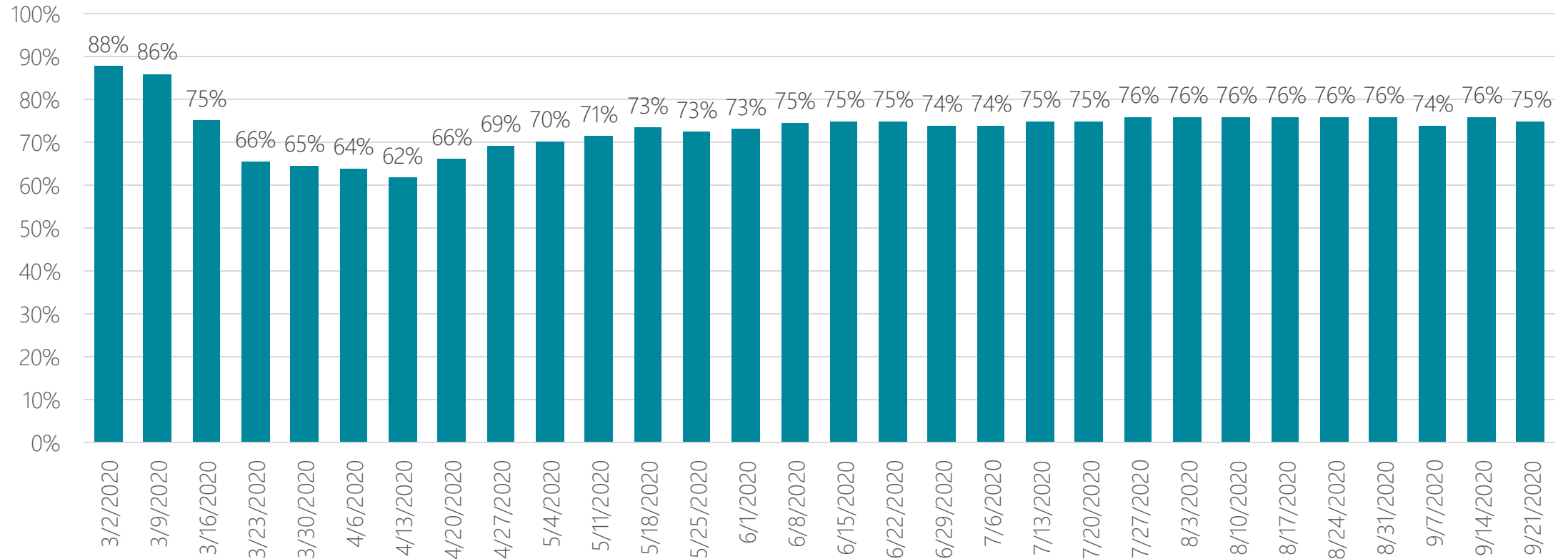
Average miles traveled on weekdays continues to remain relatively stable.
