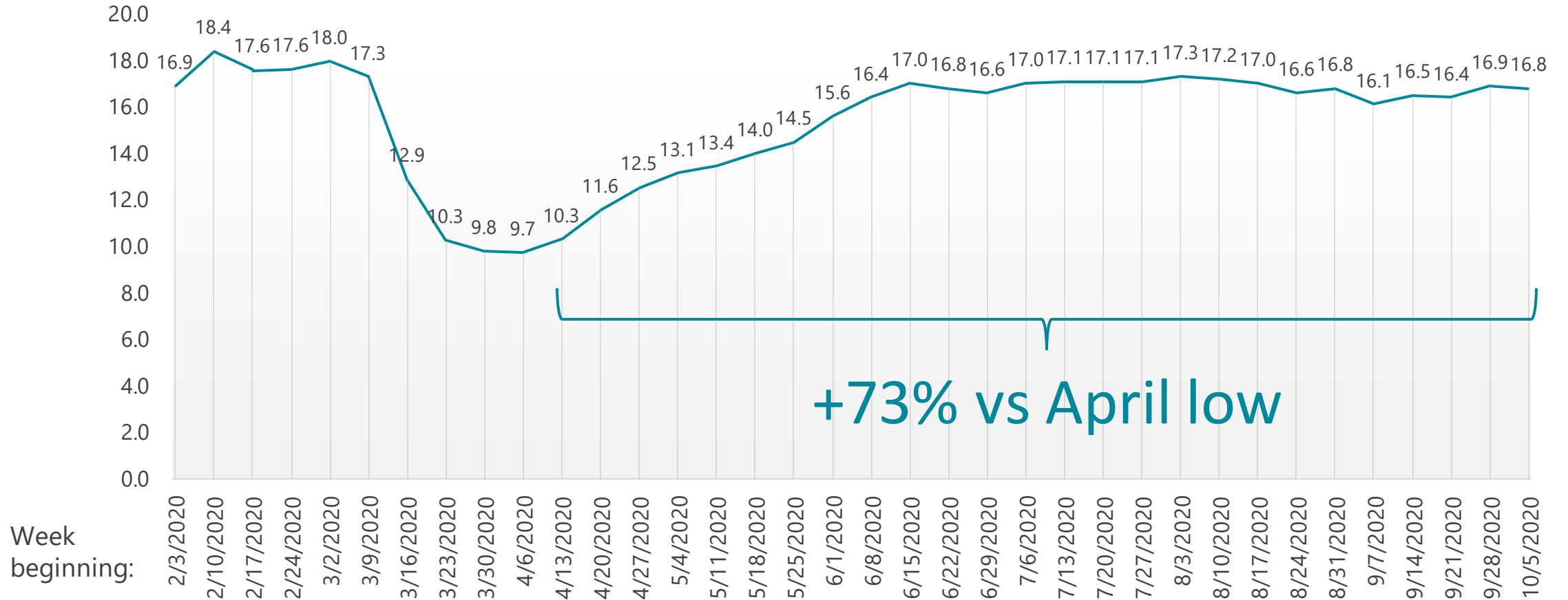

USA Average Weighted Average By County

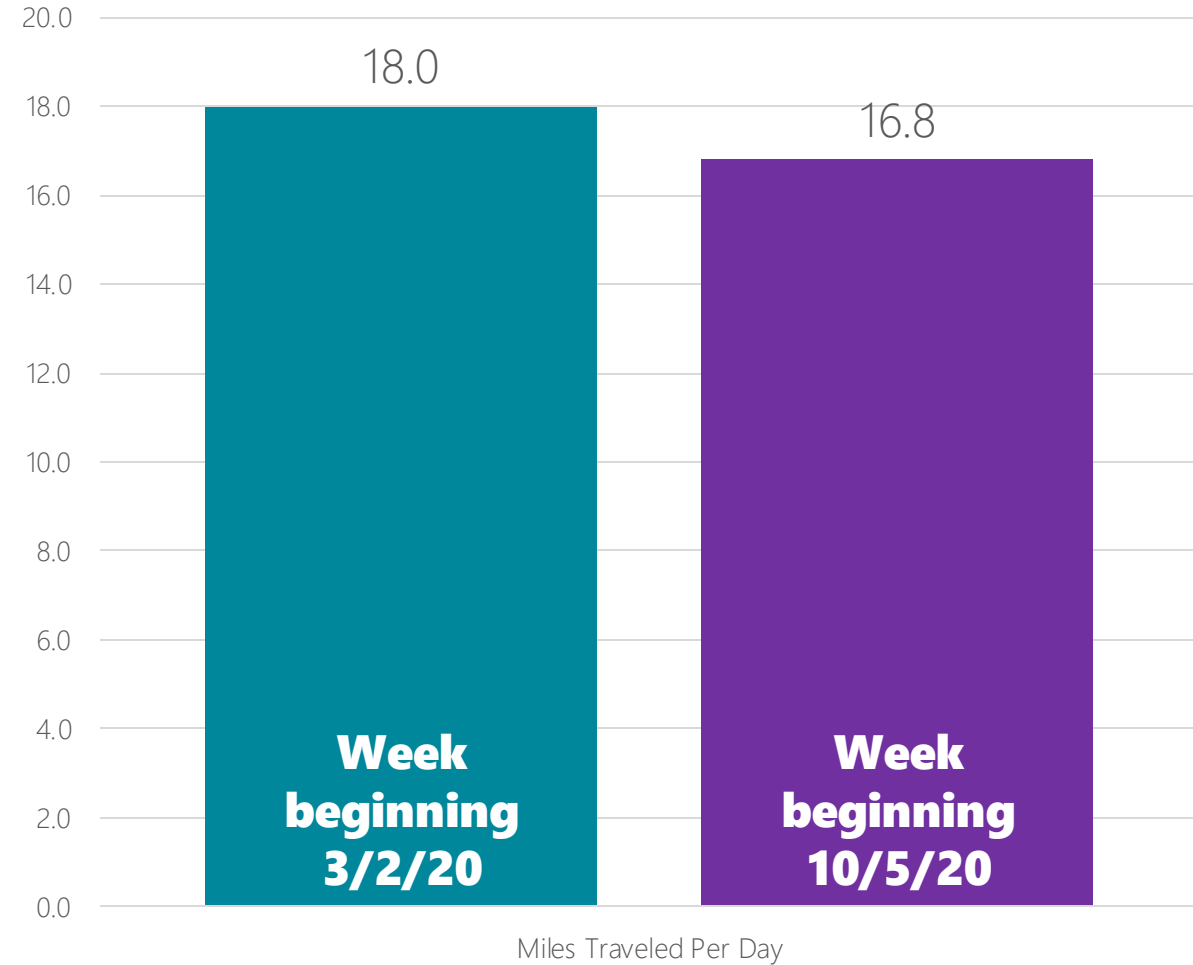
Average miles traveled per day remain relatively stable.

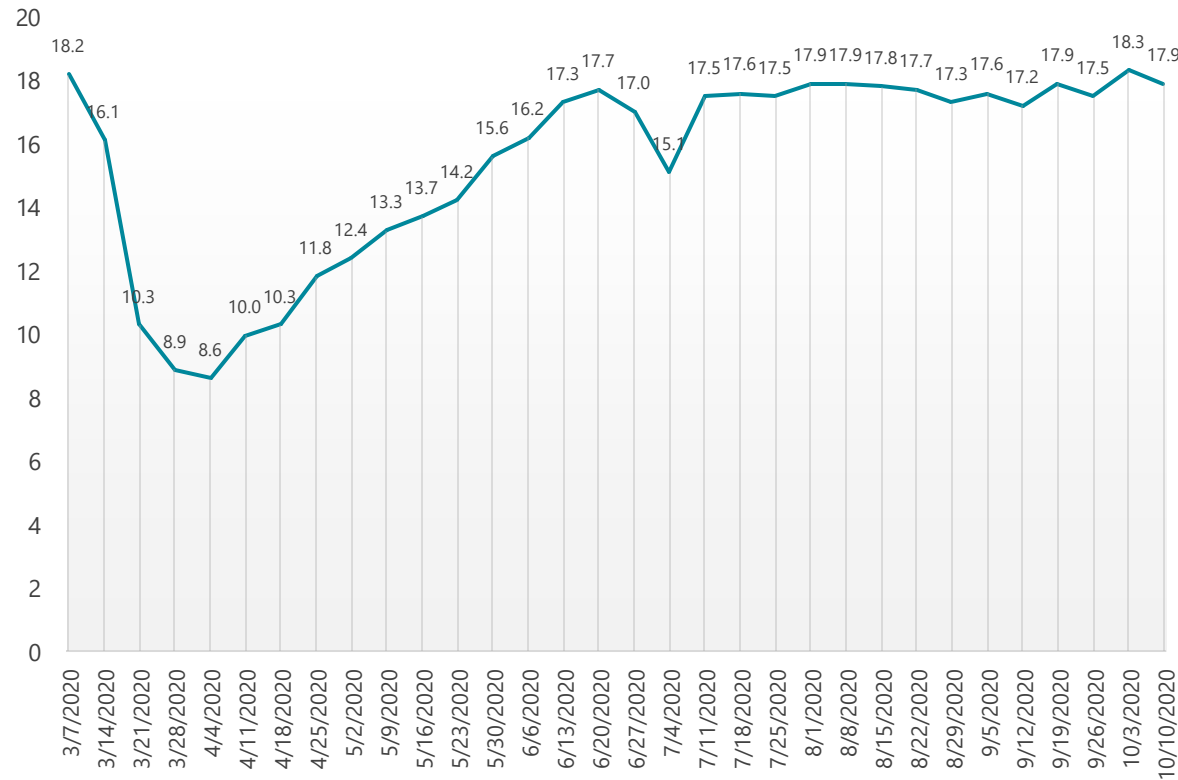
Average miles traveled daily for the week of 10/5 represents **93%** of the travel occurring the first week of March prior to COVID-19 restrictions.



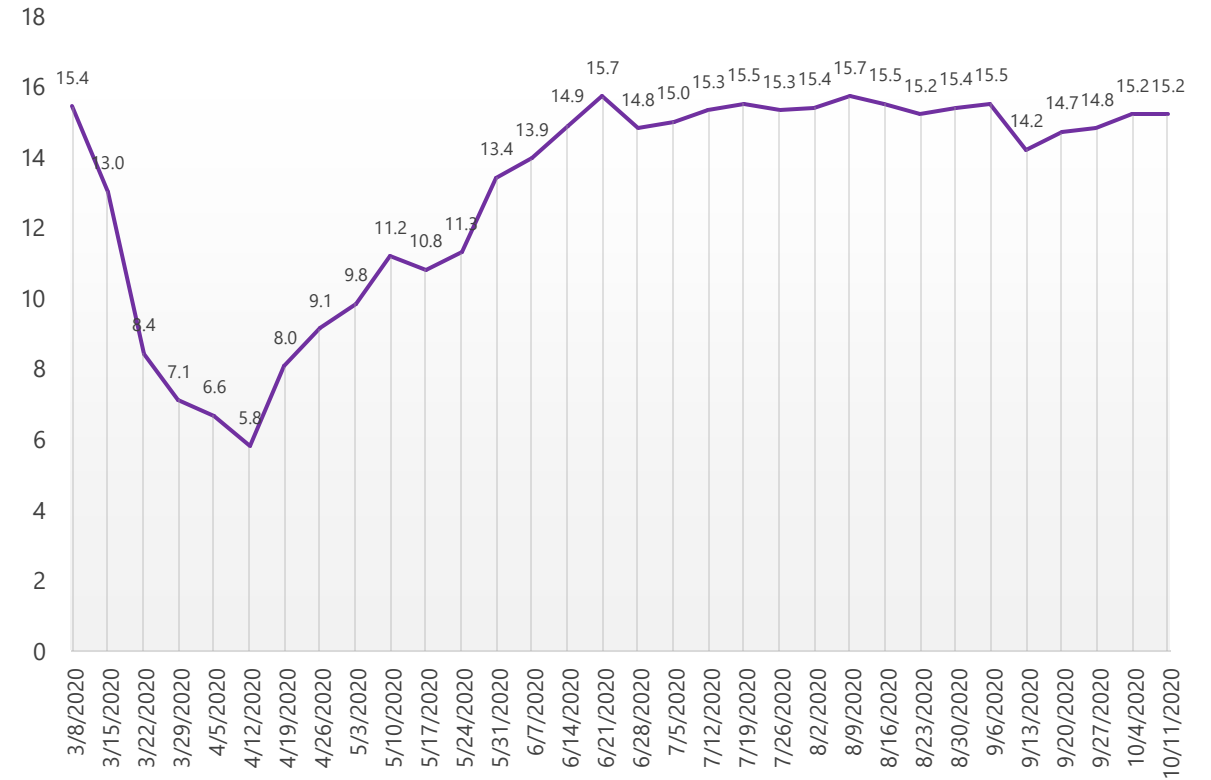
USA Average Weighted Average By County

Sundays

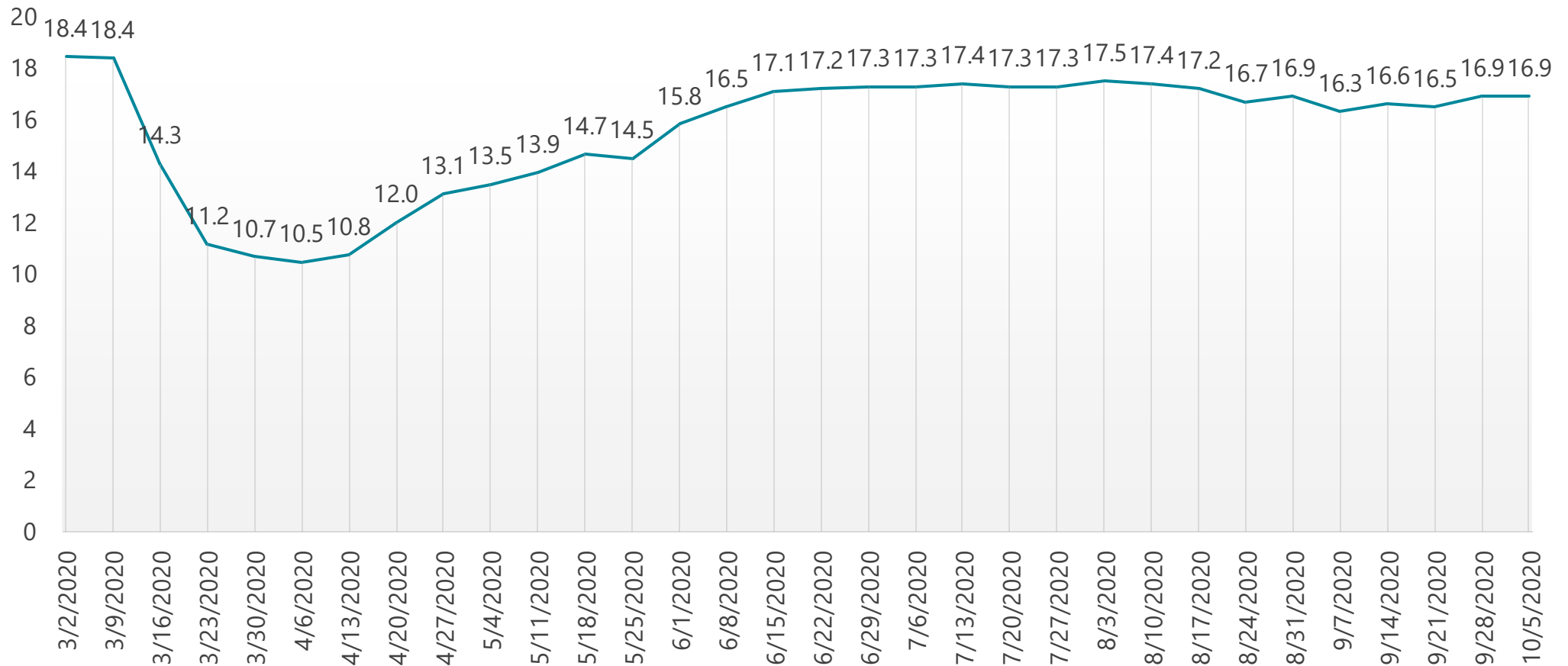


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USA Average Weighted Average By County

Average miles traveled on weekdays was flat week over week.

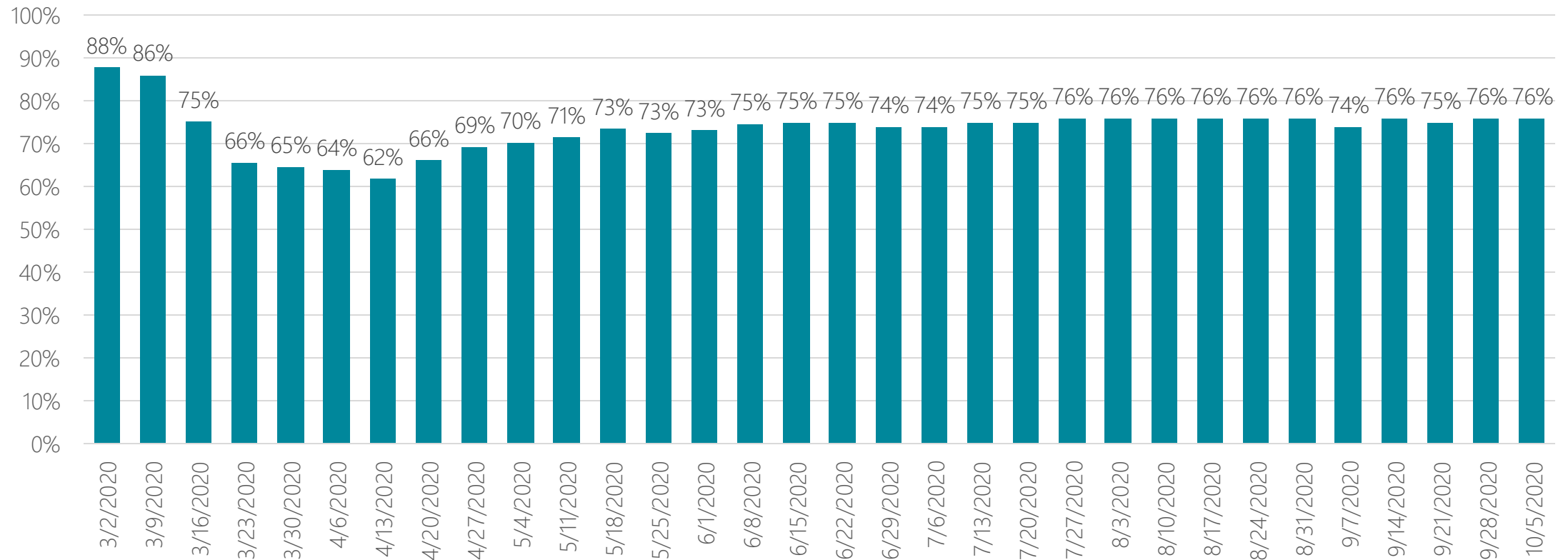
Average Week Day
