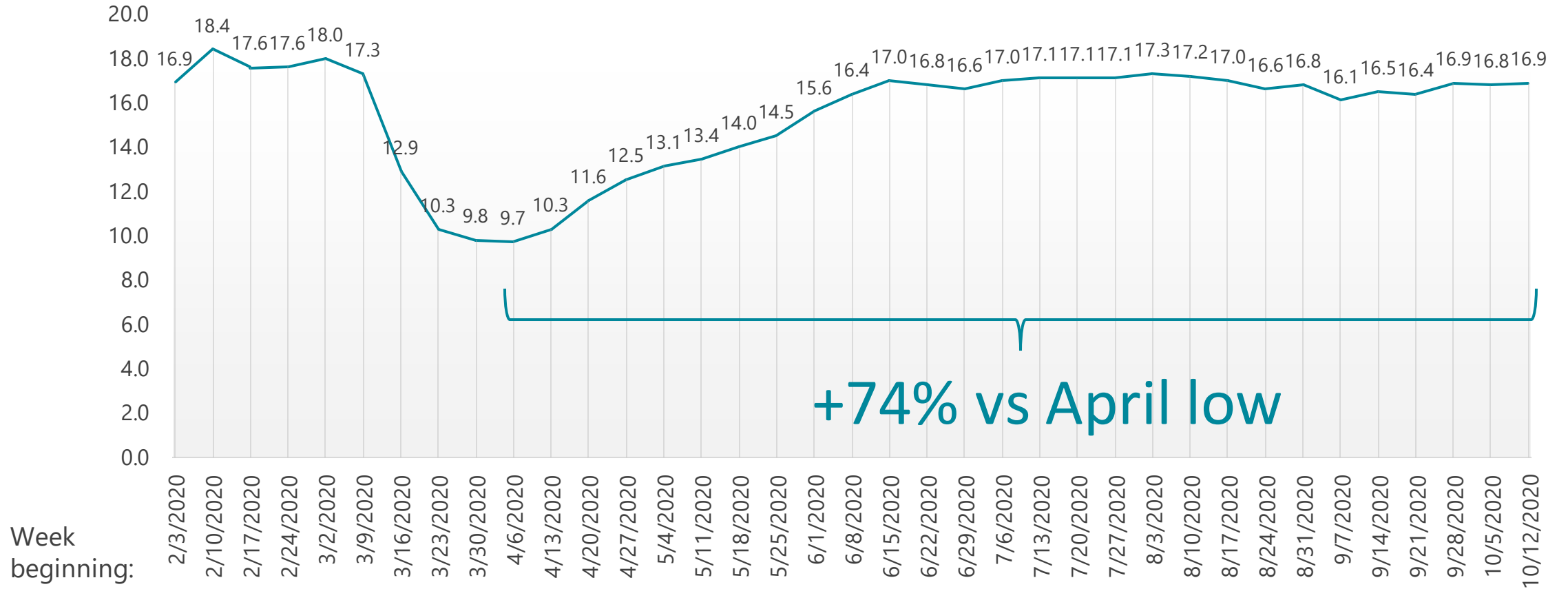

Average miles traveled per day remain relatively stable.

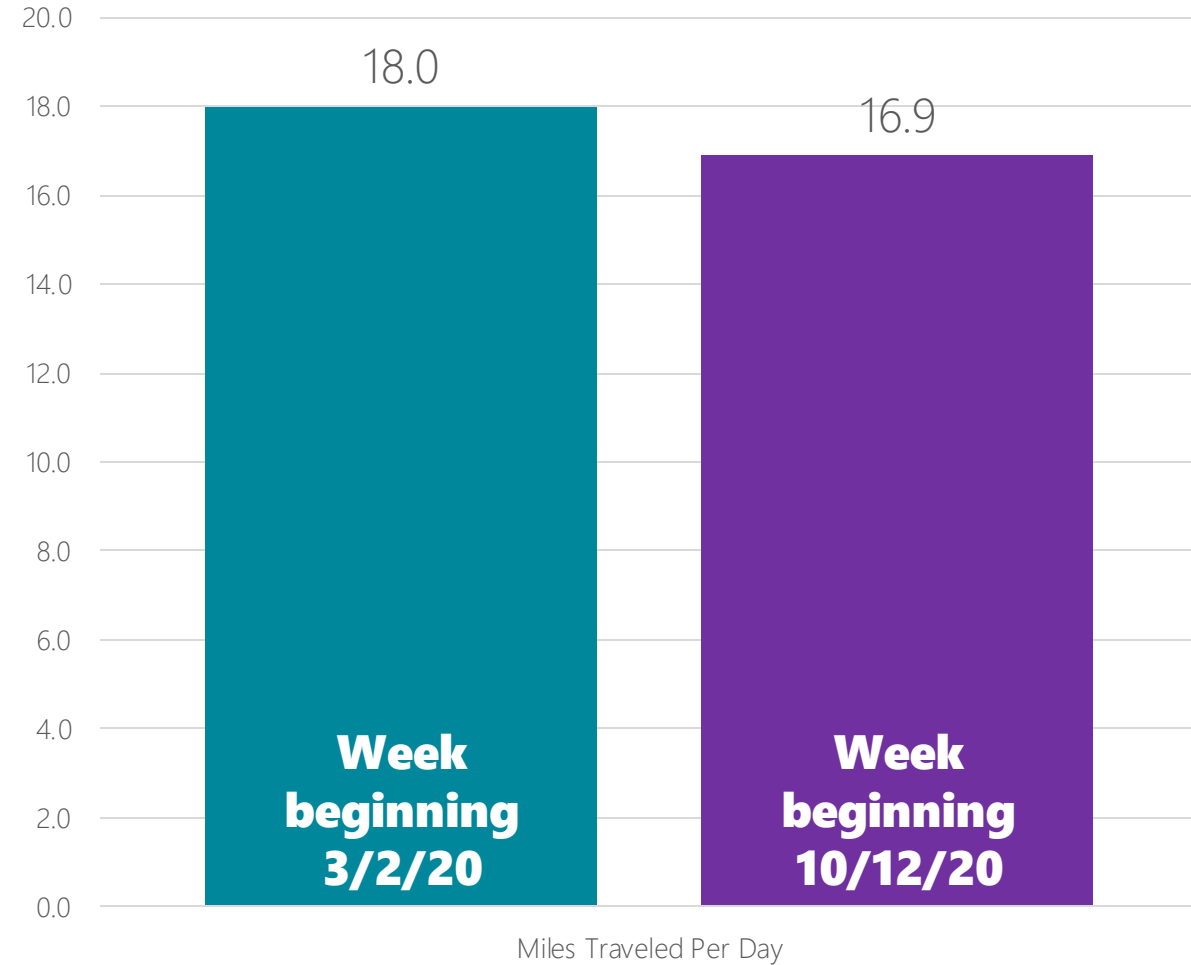
Avg Total Miles Traveled Per Day

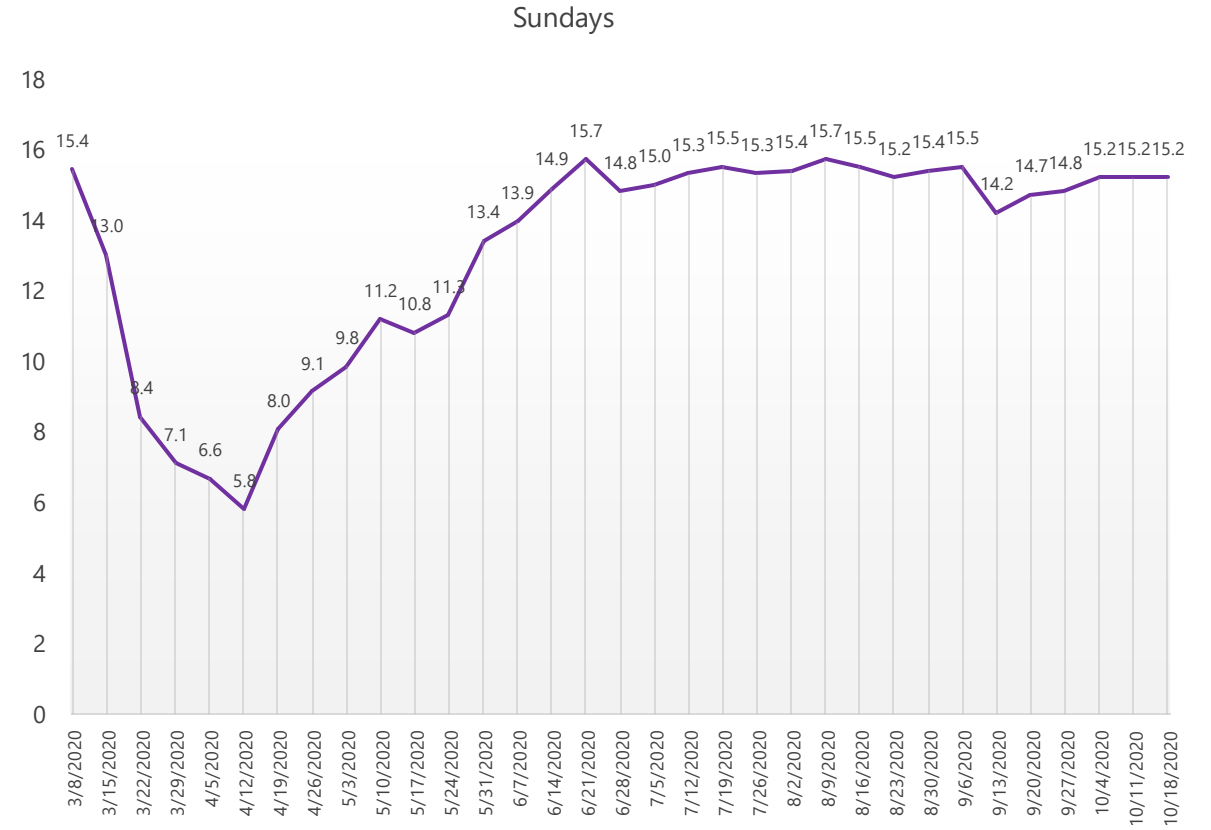
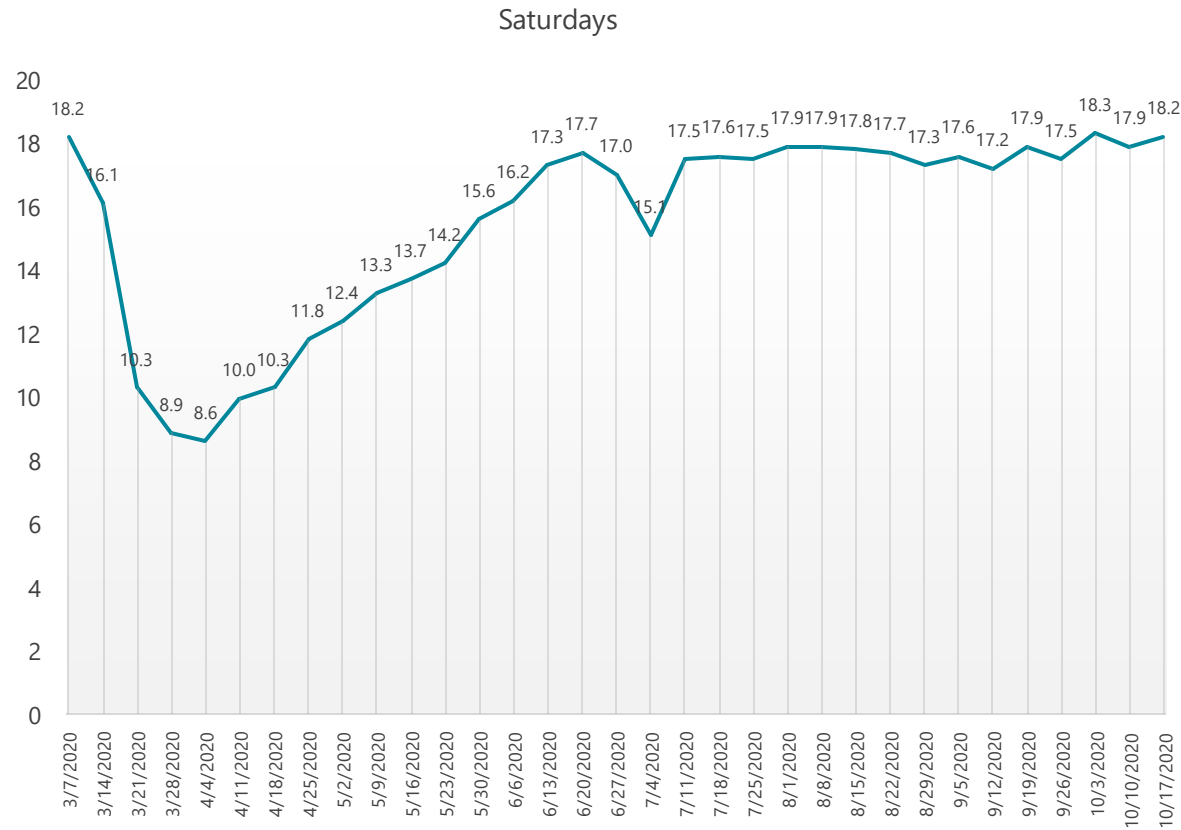
USA Average Weighted Average By County

Average miles traveled daily for the week of 10/12 represents **94%** of the travel occurring the first week of March prior to COVID-19 restrictions.



USA Average Weighted Average By County

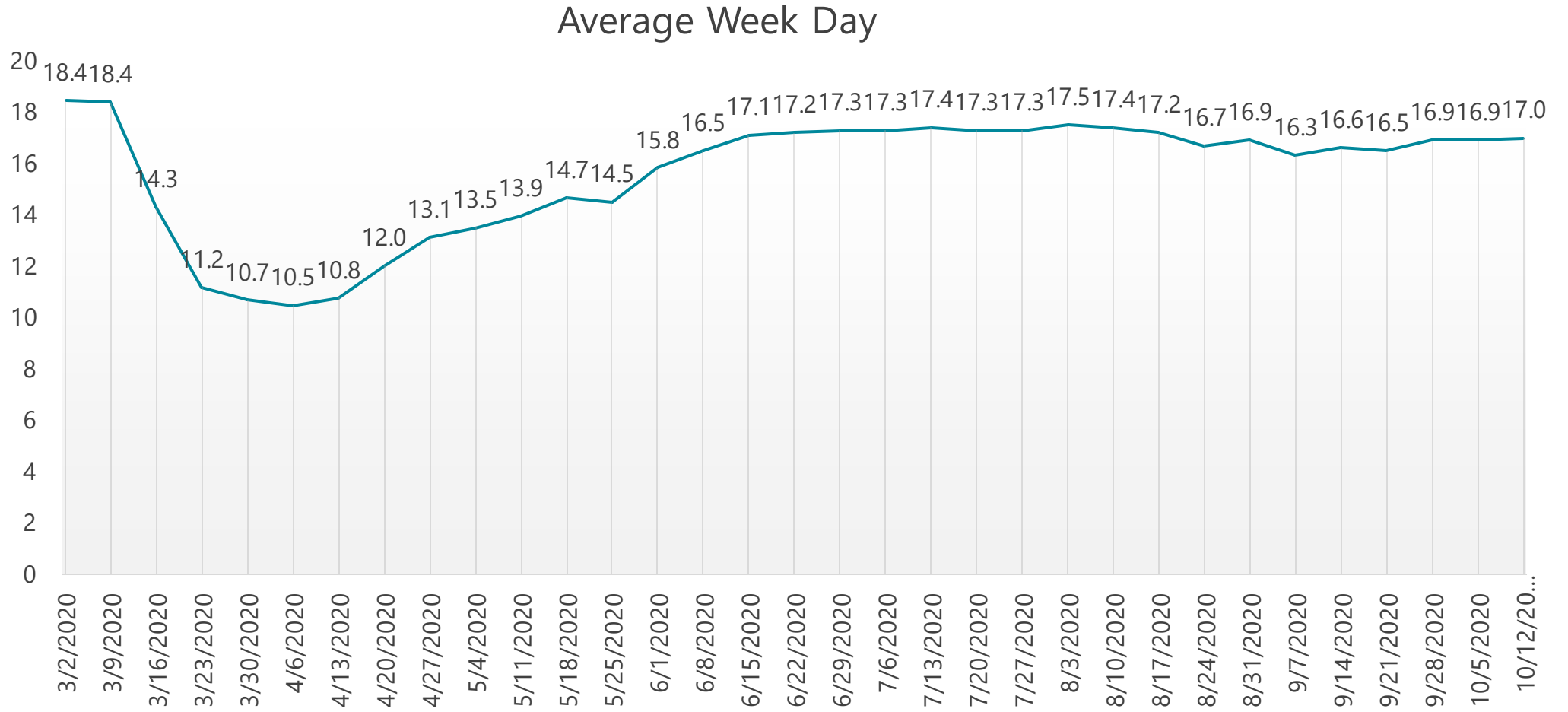
Miles traveled on weekends are also relatively stable heading into the second-half of October.



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USA Average Weighted Average By County

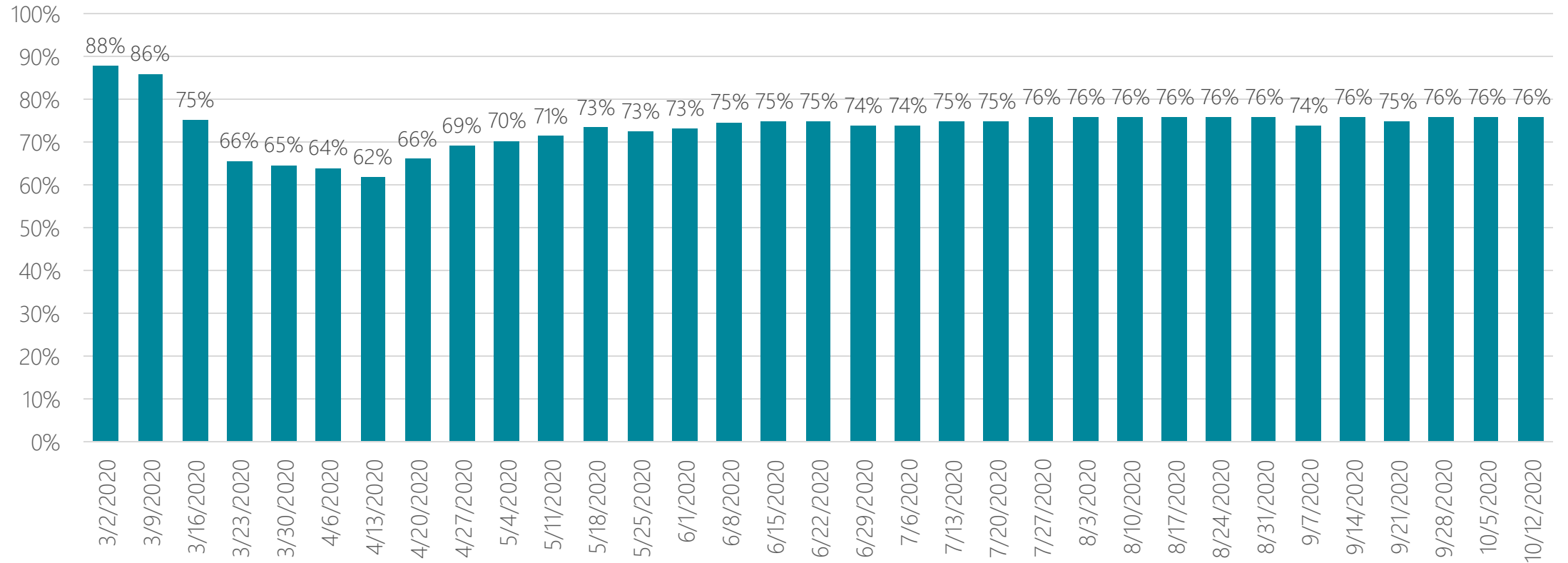
Average miles traveled on weekdays also continue to remain relatively stable.

It is worth noting that monthly data from the FHA, show seasonal variation in miles traveled nationally, with October typically demonstrating lower metrics than July and August.
