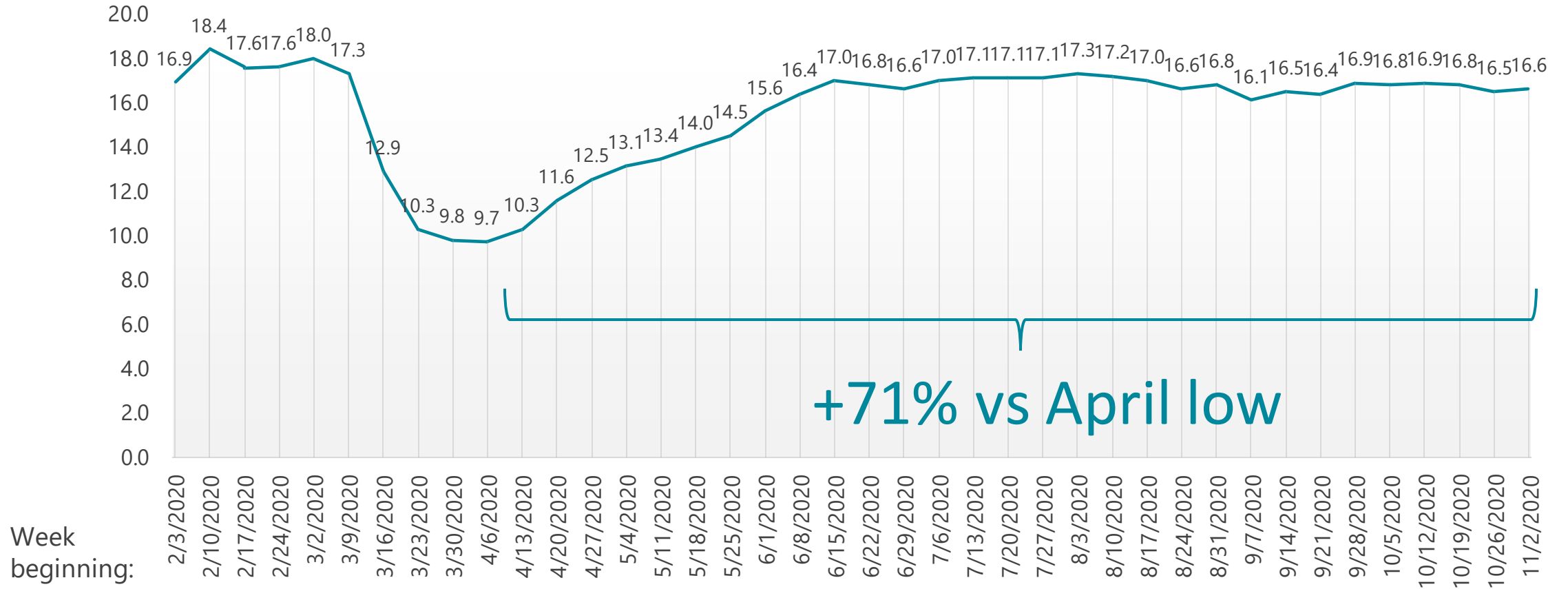

Average miles traveled per day remain relatively stable, hovering between 16.1 and 17.3 miles per average day since mid-June.

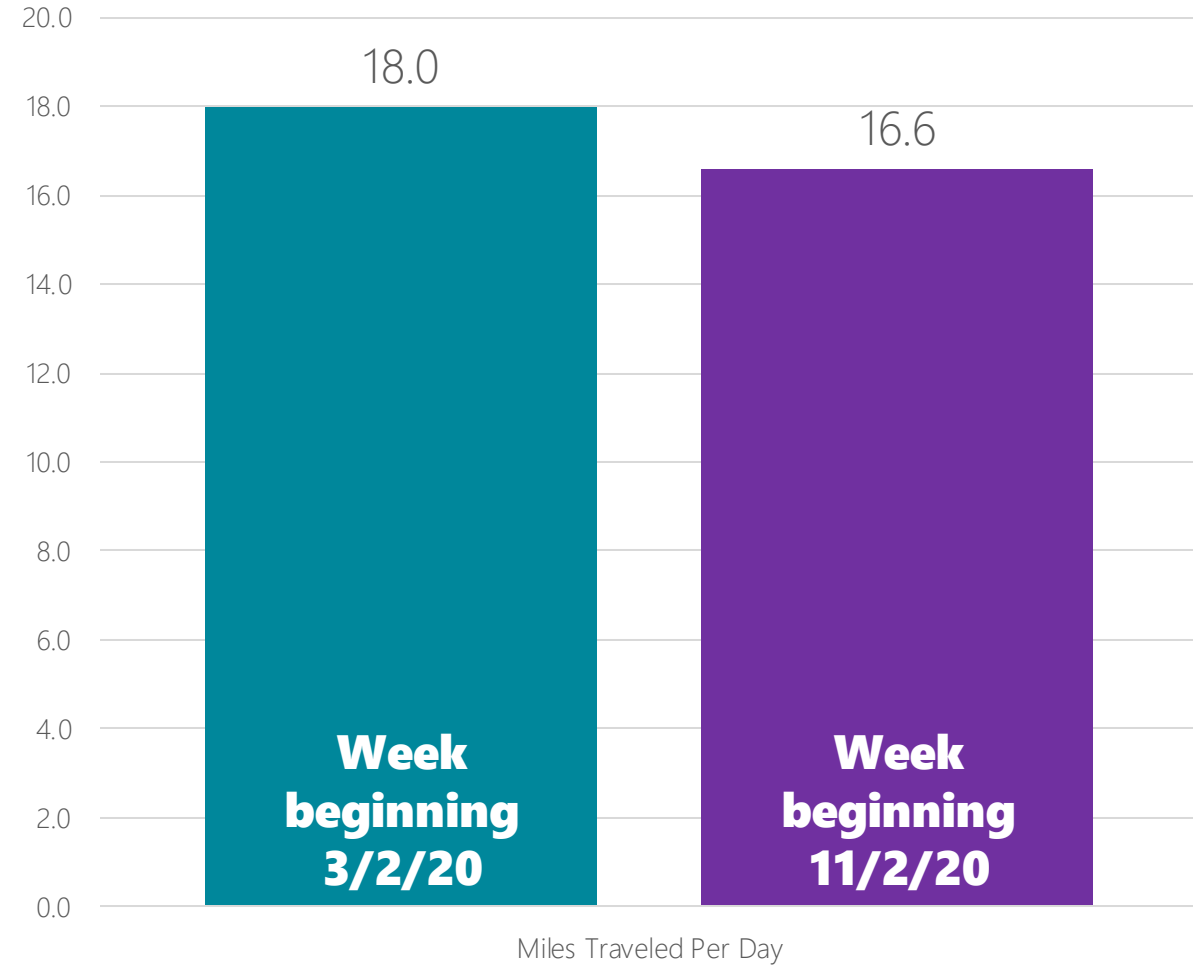
Avg Total Miles Traveled Per Day

USA Average Weighted Average By County

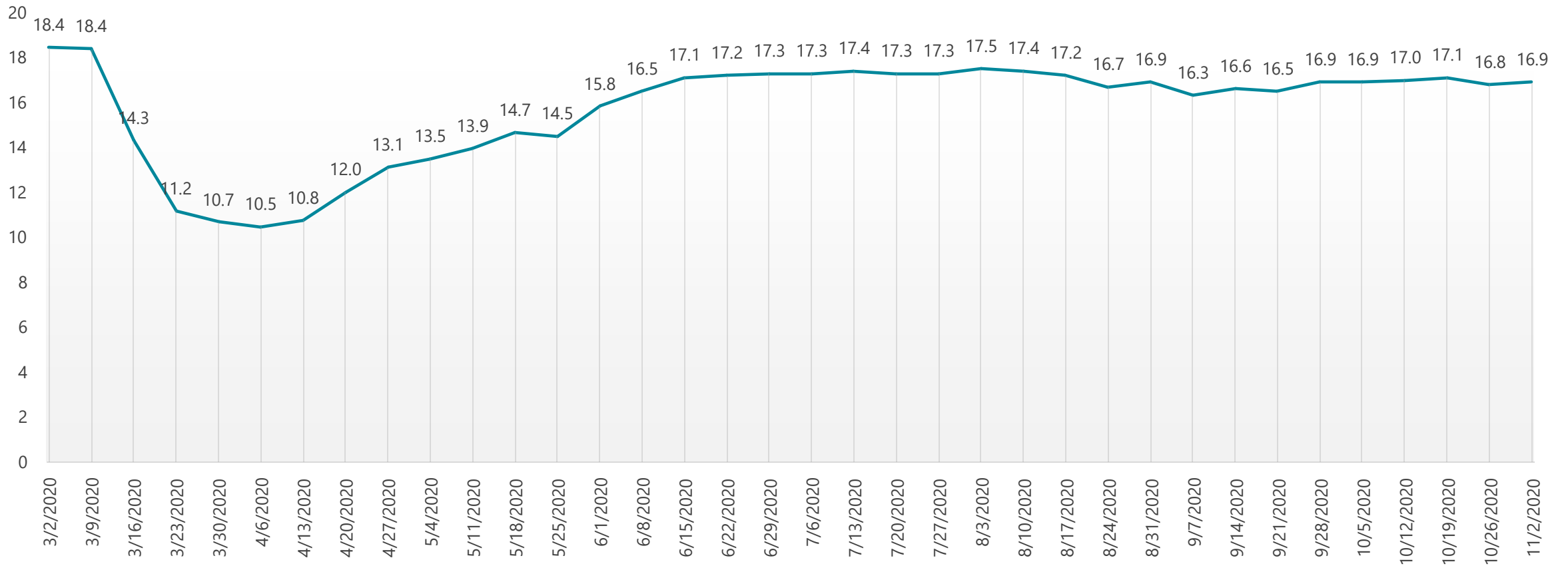
Average miles traveled daily for the week of 11/2 represents **92%** of the travel occurring the first week of March prior to COVID-19 restrictions.

Average Weekday

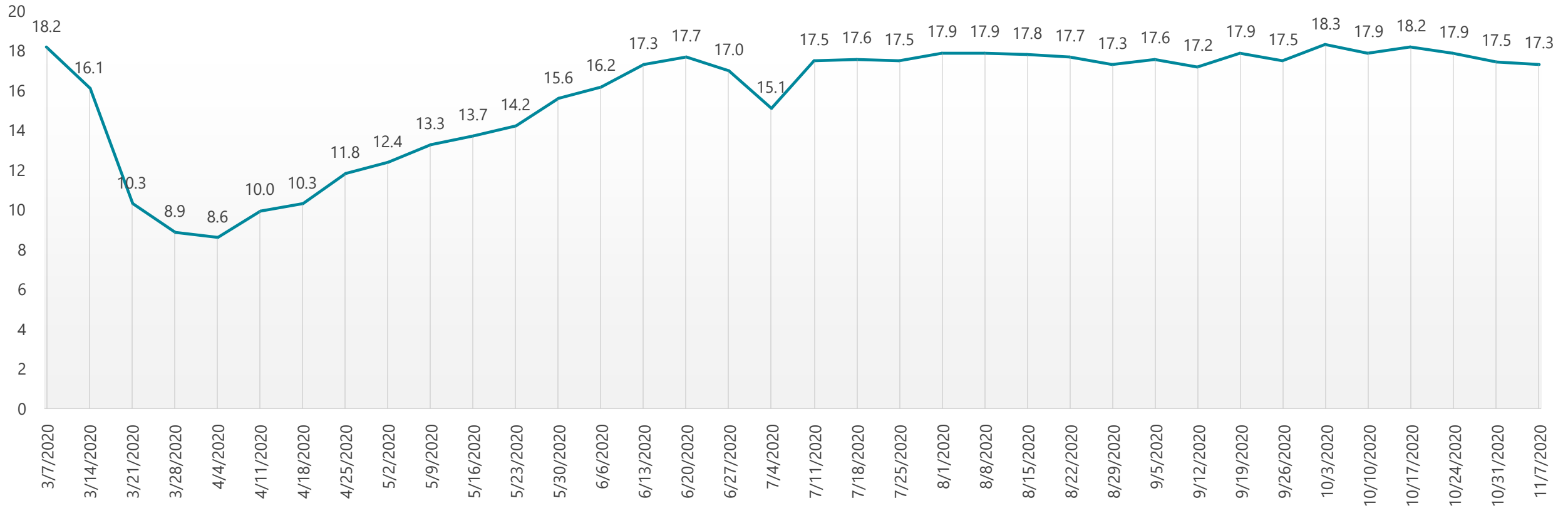

Miles traveled on weekends are also relatively stable heading into the second-half of October.

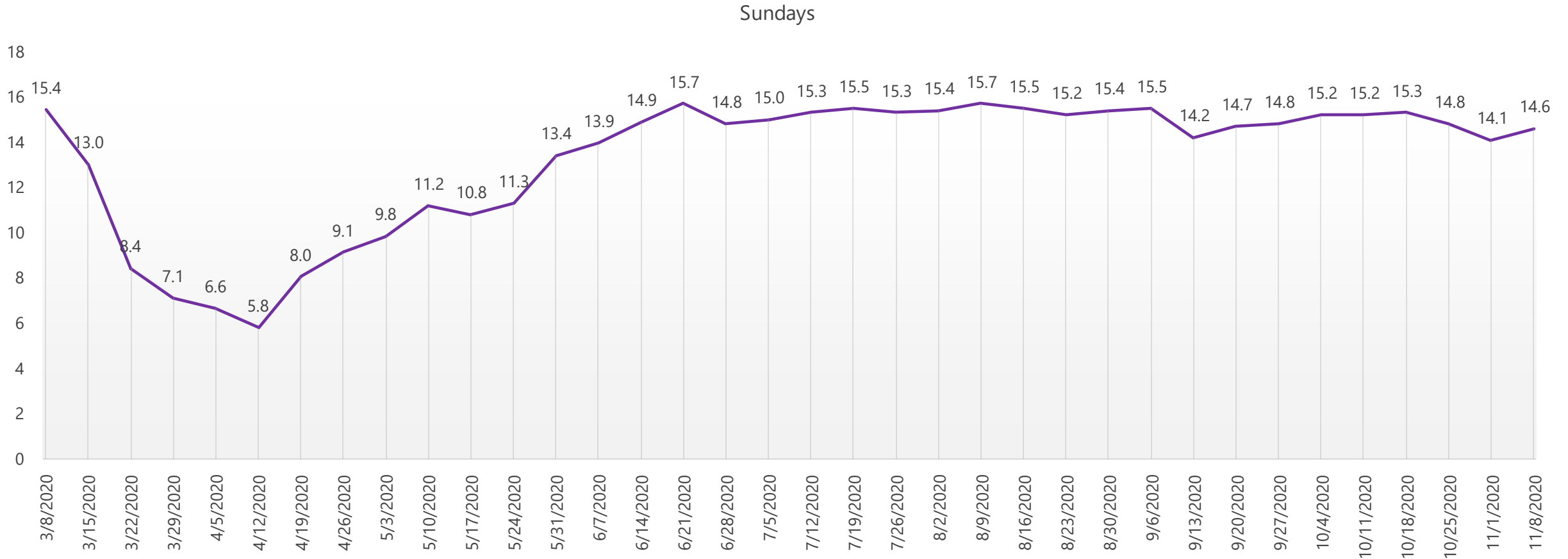

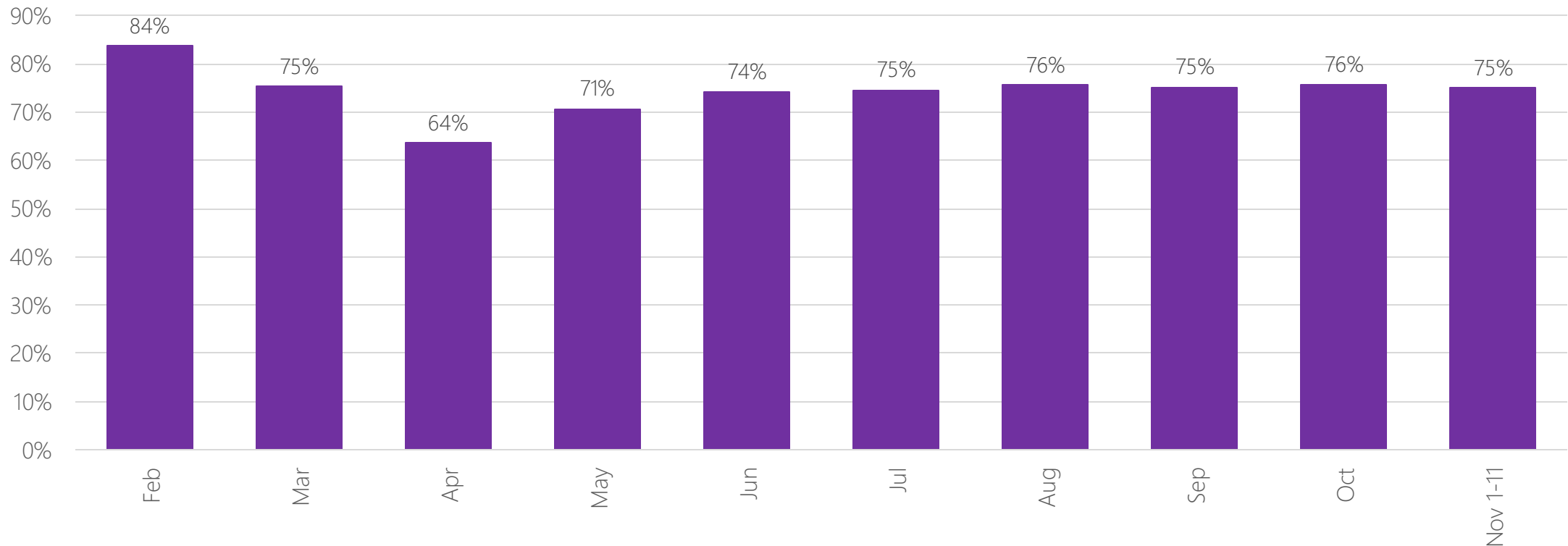
After softening last week, Sunday travel has increased week over week.
